

REPORT OF THE CHIEF INSPECTOR OF SHEEP.

Inspector of Sheep Office, Hobart Town, 10th July, 1877.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit the following Report upon the working of the Scab Act, and the condition of Sheep in Tasmania during the years 1876-7 to this date.

At the date of my last Report, the 31st July, 1876, there were 11,629 Sheep under licence and in quarantine, under Section 11, Scab Act, 1875.

The number now under licence is 5414; and I am glad to be able to say that the area within which infection exists has been considerably reduced since the date of my last Report.

The Returns appended show that now infected Sheep are only to be found in the Districts of New Norfolk, Brighton, Richmond, Spring Bay, and Huon. I fear however that, owing to the very small penalties generally inflicted by the Courts in these districts, unless I am again invested with the powers which the Act of 1875 deprived me of, or the Licence Fee is increased to such an amount as to inspire fear into the minds of the careless Sheepowners, it is hard to say how long Scab, to a small extent, may not be perpetuated in the districts where it now exists.

If the law was amended and the Licence Fee on infected Sheep made half-a-crown a head, instead of free licences in the first place and sixpence a head afterwards as at present, I think that probably the remnants of disease now existing might be got rid of during the ensuing year; but unless this is done, or the power to destroy diseased and infected Sheep exposed for sale or driven on the highways is restored, I am sorry to say that I can see no hope of that speedy and complete eradication of disease which must have taken place if the powers of the Chief Inspector had not been so much reduced by the Act of 1875.

With so few Sheep infected, the most rational course now would be to destroy the whole of them and leave the runs vacant for say 12 months, giving the owners some moderate compensation. This course was adopted in South Australia some years ago and proved most successful. It would be to the interest of Sheepowners to contribute to a special fund for this purpose; but I fear it would be impossible to get them as a body to assent to any such proposition.

The contribution for 1878, according to law, cannot be more than one farthing per head; consequently a considerable reduction in the number of Inspectors must take place.

If the Sheepowners would consent to allow me to destroy all infected Sheep at the end of the current year, and take the necessary steps to ensure the destruction of stragglers while the runs remained unstocked with Sheep for 12 months, the work could be accomplished quickly; and the cost of doing it I believe would not be more than the continuance of the present contribution for another year or two. Something under £2000, I believe, would meet all claims for compensation and cost of destroying stragglers, and then the present staff could be reduced one-half at least with perfect safety.

If I were a Sheepowner myself, either large or small, I would consider a contribution to a Special Compensation Fund to cover destruction and compensation to ensure the complete eradication of Scab as the best possible investment of money.

I believe I am quite safe in stating that no infection now exists north of New Norfolk, Bagdad, and Spring Bay. I may observe, however, that so long as it exists at all there is always a liability to outbreaks, particularly at shearing season, arising from men shearing infected sheep and then, without due, or in fact any, precautions going into other sheds. There is no power under the Act to compel men to purify their clothes, and it is only the larger Sheepowners who are fully alive to the

danger, and take the precaution to ascertain where their shearers have come from last. If the Scab Act is amended during the ensuing Session in the direction I have indicated, I think some severe penalty should be provided for men shearing infected sheep and leaving the premises without having their clothing disinfected under the supervision of an Inspector.

The number of sheep has still increased on last year's Returns, as the Table underneath discloses. It also shows the quantity of wool exported each year, from the 30th of June of one year to the 1st July of the following, made up from Customs Returns.

The above Return speaks for itself. It needs no comment from me further than drawing attention to the fact that now, with only a small increase in the number of sheep as compared with 1868-9, the quantity of wool exported in 1876-7 shows an increase on the average quantity exported in former years of 1,850,000 lbs. This increased quantity of wool is, in my opinion, solely attributable to the beneficial operation of the Scab Act. I would ask those sheepowners (and there are some) who look upon the contribution to the Scab Act Fund as a tax, to look at the above figures and consider how small a thing it is for such great things to have flowed from it. To any who doubt the correctness of the figures I would suggest a reference to their shearing returns and account sales of wool to verify them.

The number and value of Stud Sheep exported in 1876 was not so great as in 1875, as the following Return shows. But I have every reason to believe that during the current year a larger amount will be derived from that source, owing to a demand for flock rams which is springing up in some of the neighbouring Colonies. Very recently a shipment of 150 rams was made to Queensland, purchased by one sheepowner in that Colony for the use of his ordinary breeding flocks; the price paid for these rams was £7 7s. each.

To these values may fairly be added from 20 to 25 per cent. to ascertain the true value, as sheep are sometimes passed at the Custom House at from £5 to £10 each, when they may have been sold for three or four times that amount.

It affords me great satisfaction to be able to state that my efforts to get the removal of the prohibition to our sheep entering New South Wales *via* the River Murray and Victoria have proved successful, notwithstanding the powerful influences brought to bear against it. The restrictions imposed by the New South Wales Regulations of the 26th April last are somewhat severe; much more so indeed than I think there is the slightest necessity for, but I have very little doubt about their being modified and made less restrictive before another year passes away.

The number of bullocks and sheep imported in 1876 was less than in 1875 by 406 bullocks and 10,917 sheep.

The number of cattle returned in the Live Stock Statistics for the last five years shows a considerable increase.

In the imports of cattle is included 18 head of stud cattle from Victoria valued at £3040. So that if that is taken into consideration the decrease in the amount paid for imported fat bullocks as compared with 1875 is very marked indeed. Taking sheep and cattle together, and putting aside the 18 head of stud cattle referred to above, the cost of beef and mutton imported in 1876 was only about half the amount paid during the preceding year, viz., £36,462 in 1875, and to £18,668 in 1876. This result may be attributed to three causes, first, and the principal one, is the increased number of fat sheep which the operation of the Scab Act has produced; second, the high price of fat stock in the neighbouring colonies; and third, the increased facilities which the Main Line of Railway affords for bringing fat stock to market.

In 1875 rabbit skins to the number of 433,404, valued at £3653, were exported. In 1876, 624,996 skins were exported, valued at £3879. It will be observed that although nearly a third more skins were exported in 1876 than in 1875, there is only about £200 difference in the value. The reason for this I cannot get any satisfactory explanation of. However that is of small moment. It is not the value I desire to draw attention to but the number.

In every Report I have made for some years past I have expressed a strong opinion as to the increase of the rabbit plague, and I am sorry to say that my prognostications are more than verified. Rabbits are overspreading the land, and what the consequences will be before many years elapse unless settlers generally take the matter up in the way that a few have done and are doing in the Midland District it would be impossible to divine. I fear they will be very disastrous to individuals as well as most injurious to public interests.

The Reports from New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, and Victoria are, that the sheep in those colonies remain absolutely free from the scab disease. From New Zealand I have only reports from the Provinces of Hawkes Bay and Otago. There also the sheep are free from disease.

The number of sheep specially inspected by the District Inspectors from the 30th June, 1876, to the 30th June, 1877, is 747,346, and miles travelled, 33,103.

Appended to this Report is a detailed Return of Sheep throughout the Municipal and Police Districts, showing their condition at this date, together with the names of the owners.
