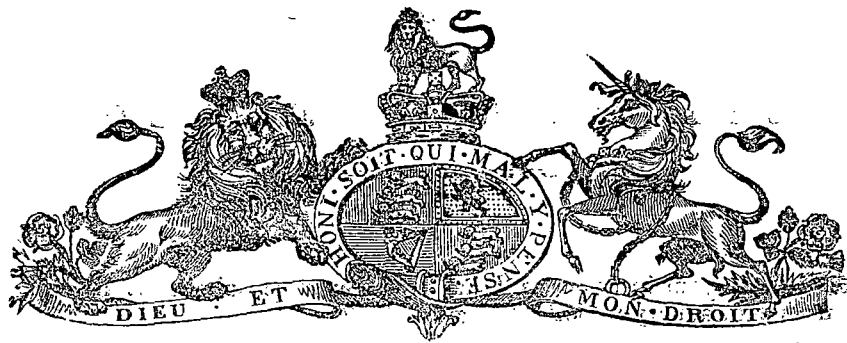

On the 1st April I was appointed to the charge of the department, and on the 10th April the women and children were transferred to H. M. Gaol, Hobart Town.

CASCADES TRAINING SCHOOL FOR JUVENILE OFFENDERS.

30th April, 1878.

SIR,

IN accordance with your instructions, I have the honor to submit my Report upon the above Establishment from 1st January to 30th November, 1877.

On the 1st April I was appointed to the charge of the Establishment, and on the 9th October the Certificate of the School was withdrawn by the Government.

I beg to annex the under-mentioned Returns :—

- A. Return showing the number of Juvenile Offenders received and discharged.
- B. Return showing the Receipts and Expenditure.

The net cost per head per annum was £23 12s. 1½d., as compared with £20 5s. 3½d. for the previous year, caused by reduced numbers. At the closing of the School a large quantity of stores remained on hand, and have been returned to the Colonial Storekeeper.
