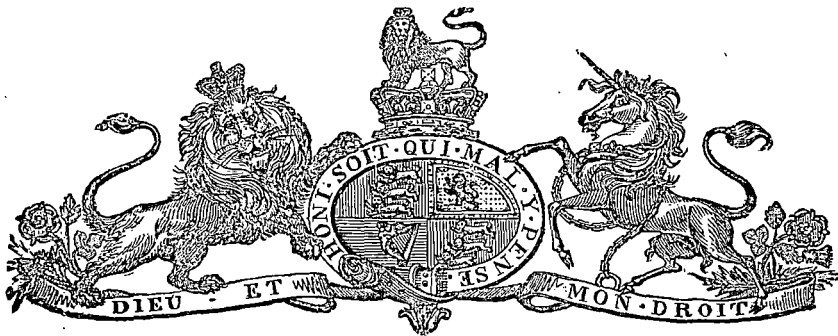

The humble Petition of the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Westbury in Council
duly assembled.

SHOWETH :

THAT, in the opinion of your Petitioners, it is desirable that the Thirty-third and Thirty-fourth Clauses of "The Municipal Police Act," and the Eighty-fourth Clause of "The Rural Municipalities Act," should be repealed; and that the Thirtieth and Thirty-fifth Clauses of "The Municipal Police Act," and the Eighty-sixth Clause of "The Rural Municipalities Act," should be amended in accordance therewith.

Your Petitioners therefore humbly pray that a Bill may be passed repealing and amending the above-recited Sections accordingly.
