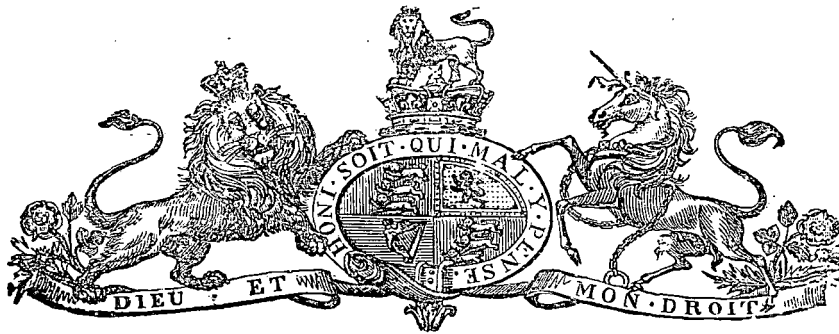

IN presenting the Annual Report of this Institution for 1878, we are in a position to acknowledge the able services of the Surgeon-Superintendent in the general management of it.

We, at the same time, desire to accord to the other officials their due share of praise in the performance of duties necessarily of a trying nature.

The buildings have been kept in repair and in perfect cleanliness; and the recreation ground, which was available during the latter months of the year, afforded an agreeable change for exercise to those patients willing to be placed there upon all suitable occasions.

The Surgeon-Superintendent reports that several cases of sickness were treated in hospital, but that only two deaths occurred.
