**An Act to amend the *Ambulance Service Act 1982* and the
*Health Act 1997***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Health Amendment
(Quality Assurance Committees) Act 2007*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this
Act receives the Royal Assent.
