

CONSOLIDATED FUND APPROPRIATION BILL (No. 1) 2008

FACT SHEET

The Consolidated Fund Appropriation Bill (No. 1) 2008 will be introduced into Parliament on 12 June 2008.

The bill provides budget appropriations to the major agencies and is a routine piece of financial legislation that provides for the implementation of the Government's policy priorities.

The bill provides funding to agencies of \$3 501 098 000 to meet recurrent and works and services expenditure requirements for the 2008-09 financial year.
