CONSOLIDATED FUND APPROPRIATION BILL (NO. 1) 2011

- The Consolidated Fund Appropriation Bill (No. 1) 2011 will be introduced into Parliament on 16 June 2011.
- The Bill provides Budget appropriations to the major agencies and is a routine piece of financial legislation that provides for the implementation of the Government's policy priorities.
- The Bill provides funding to agencies of \$4 261 415 000 to meet recurrent and works and services expenditure requirements for the 2011-12 financial year.
