**REPORT.**

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report:—

**PENGUIN COUNCIL APPLICATION.**

Your Committee, having taken into consideration an application from the Penguin Council for a loan of £500 for the purpose of defraying the cost and expenses of, and incidental to, the completion, carrying out, or extension of all or any of the works or objects authorised by the Principal Act, recommends the same to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House.

**BURSARIES BOARD APPLICATION.**

This was an application for a loan to the Public Trustee of £2000 for the purposes referred to in Section Three of the Bursaries Act, 1925. After due consideration your Committee decided to recommend the loan.

**BURNIE COUNCIL APPLICATION.**

This was an application for a loan of £25,000 for the purpose of defraying the cost and expenses of, or connected with, installing a further supply of water for the Town of Burnie. After carefully considering the abovementioned application your Committee decided to defer further consideration of the proposal with a view to obtaining the report of the Engineer of Works.
