#### COMMISSIONER'S REPORT FOR YEAR 1894.

#### Police Department, Commissioner's Office, Hobart, 6th April, 1895.

Sir,

I HAVE the honor to submit my Annual Report upon the Territorial Police for the year 1894. Four Constables resigned during the year; one Sub-Inspector was disrated; there were no dismissals, and no deaths.

The reductions during the year were the Sub-Inspector at Moorina and one Constable at Dundas. Since the close of the year, however, still further reductions have been effected to the extent of two Superintendents, one Sub-Inspector, and ten Constables, as follows:—The Superintendents of George Town and South Longford, the District of George Town being placed under the charge of the Superintendent of the Selby District; the Sub-Inspector at St. Leonard's, replaced by a Constable; one Constable at each of the stations at Sandy Bay, George Town, and Emu Bay; and the Constables at Mount Stuart, Leslie, Branxholm, Weldborough, Lower Piper River, Don, and Sassafras, which stations have been closed. The Sub-Inspector heretofore stationed at Beaconsfield is now resident at George Town in the same District.

The increased mining population at the Pieman River and at Mount Lyell in the Macquarie District rendered it necessary to establish stations at Corinna and Gormanston, at each of which places a Constable has been stationed. Since the close of the year a station with two Constables has been established at the King River, in the same District, where the Mount Lyell Railway is being constructed; and an additional Constable has been stationed at Lefroy, in the George Town District.

The establishment of a Town Board at Beltana, in the Rural Municipality of Clarence, in November last had the effect of adding that place for Police purposes and control to the District of New Town.

I was called upon on 19th July last to undertake the duties of Police Magistrate of Hobart, and was consequently unable to visit and complete the inspection of all the Districts. During the year I visited the Districts of Franklin, Emu Bay, Macquarie, and Selby.

The appointment of the Inspecting Superintendent was not made until 1st January of this year. He will in future perform the greater part of the duty of inspection, which heretofore devolved upon the Commissioner.

The Offices of the Commissioner and Clerical Branch, and the Head Quarters of the Superintendent of New Town and other Districts combined under his charge, were removed on 28th November last from the premises at the corner of Macquarie and Elizabeth streets to Liverpoolstreet, where accommodation is also provided for the Police Court and the Officers attached to the Magisterial Department now under my charge.

The efficient performance of duty by the Officers of the Clerical Branch at Head Quarters merits special commendation; and the Officers in charge of Districts and Sub-Districts, as well as the Constables generally throughout the Colony, during a period of increased responsibility arising out of the great depression which prevailed, also performed their duty in a most creditable manner.

The amount to the credit of "The Territorial Police Provident Fund" on the 31st December, 1894, was:—Superannuation Branch, £6621 14s. 8d.; Reward Branch, £1484 16s. 5d.

The amount paid to members of the Force who retired during the year was £167 15s. 7d., and the amount of rewards given was £146 12s. 3d.

I append the usual Return showing the strength and distribution of the Police during the year-I also attach the usual tabulated comparative statement of offences reported in the Territorial Police Districts. It will be noticed that the great decrease in drunkenness and offences against the Police Act which marked the year 1893 was maintained in 1894, whilst there was a slight increase in offences of a more serious nature.
