ANNUAL REPORT of the TASMANIAN COUNCIL OF EDUCATION for the Year 1883-84.

To His Excellency SIR GEORGE CUMINE STRAHAN, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Twenty-fourth Report of the proceedings of the Council from 1st May, 1883, to 30th April, 1884. 22 Vict. No. 1. Section 30.

2. The Hon. W. R. Giblin was elected President for the year ending 30th June, 1884. President.

3. The Annual Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions was held in the month of June, 1883. Twelve male and three female Students presented themselves for examination; and, on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of the annual value of £20 each for four years were awarded to the under-mentioned Candidates:—Alfred Thomas Harris, High School; Arthur John Lewis Burbury, High School; William Joshua Tilley Stops, Mr. Ireland's Scotch College; Francis Graham Moon Chancellor, High School; Charles Alfred Hogg, Collegiate Institute, Launceston. Council of Education Exhibitions, Gazette Notice, 26th June, 1883.

The Examiners, in closing their Report, observe:—

"The results of the Examination compare favourably with those of last year, both in the individual marks and the general average, as well as in the number of those who have qualified.

"We are glad to observe that the Senior Exhibitioner is the holder of an Exhibition under the Board of Education."

4. The twenty-fourth examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in December, 1883; M. H. Irving, Esq., M.A., Melbourne, being Examiner in English, French, German, Latin, and Greek; the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., Examiner in History and Geography, Pure Mathematics, Natural Philosophy, Chemistry, and Geology; the Rev. Thos. Kelsh, Examiner in Italian; Henry Hunter, Esq., Examiner in Drawing; and J. Summers, Esq., Examiner in Music. Thirteen Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves, and ten succeeded in obtaining the Degree,—six being placed in the First Class, three in the Second Class, and one in the Third Class. Degree of Associate of Arts, Gazette Notice, 18th Dec., 1883.

Five Candidates over nineteen years of age presented themselves. All passed, one being placed in the First Class, three in the Second, and one in the Third.

Edwin Arthur Lamprill, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal; he also gained the First Prizes for English and German. Prizes were also awarded to the under-mentioned Associates who were placed in the First Class, as follows:—Henry Frank Miles, First Prizes for Latin and Greek; George Ernest Clemons, Second Prize for French; Richard Fitzarthur Waller, Second Prize for English, and Prizes for Chemistry, Geology, and Drawing. The Second Class:—Reginald Kerr Manning, a Prize for Mathematics; William Ring Bennett, Second Prize for Mathematics; George Patten Adams, Second Prize for Latin, and a Prize for French; and in the Third Class, Henry Vere Poulett-Harris, a Prize for Music.

The Examiners, in closing their Report, observe :—

“On the whole, the Examination just closed compares very fairly with former years in all respects save the number of Candidates; but it may be remarked that no fewer than six others who had entered withdrew.”

Tasmanian Scholarships, *Gazette* Notice, 18th Dec., 1883.

5. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships took place in December last, and was conducted by M. H. Irving, Esq., M.A., and the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D. Five Candidates presented themselves; two—Evertt Gordon Allport, A.A., 1880, and John Joseph Macnamara, A.A., 1881—reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each of them, and they have since proceeded to England to enter upon their University studies.

Two other Candidates—James Harcourt Smith, A.A., 1881, and Frederick Charles Hales, A.A., 1881—came within the limits of eligibility for a Scholarship.

Progress of Tasmanian Scholars.

6. We learn with regard to the progress of Tasmanian Scholars in Great Britain, that Mr. G. A. Webster, of Caius College, Cambridge, graduated B.A. with Honours in the Natural Science Tripos in May, 1883, Third Class, and that he was the only man of his College who succeeded in taking the Honors Degree in Science. Mr. J. N. Clemons, of Corpus Christi College, Oxford, has passed his examination for Moderations with Honors, and has since entered at Lincoln's Inn. Mr. John Warnock, of Edinburgh University, has passed his second professional examination in Medicine. Mr. C. W. Rock, of Clare College, Cambridge, at the examination of Freshmen in May, 1883, was head of all the men of his College, and was elected to a Lady Clare Scholarship of the value of £60 per annum. Mr. F. Lodge, of New College, Oxford, stood first in one of five subjects, and second in each of the others, at a College Examination at the close of July Term, 1883; he has also taken Honors in Classical Moderations, and entered the Inner Temple in January last. Mr. P. L. Waterhouse, of Christ's College, Cambridge, passed First Class in all three parts of his “Little-go” Examination. Mr. W. H. Tofft, Edinburgh University, has matriculated and passed his preliminary examination in Medicine. He has also passed an examination in Mechanics with credit. Mr. C. S. Dowdell has passed the matriculation examination of London University with First Class Honors, and has entered at University College as a Student of Medicine.

Minor Scholarships.

7. The two Minor Scholarships at the disposal of the Council for the year have been awarded to Edwin Arthur Lamprill and William Leslie Giblin, they having intimated their intention to study and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship. These Scholarships are each of the value of £40 per annum, and are tenable for two years.

Dry Scholarship.

8. The Dry Scholarship was awarded to Edwin Arthur Lamprill, Senior Associate of the year, he having announced his intention of studying for the Tasmanian Scholarship Examination.

Local Examination for Matriculation at Melbourne University.

9. Since the publication of our last Report two examinations for Matriculation at the University of Melbourne have been held in Hobart under our supervision. At the Examination known as end of February Term, which was held in June, 1883, two

Candidates presented themselves, but did not succeed in passing; and for the October Term Examination, which was held in December, to which seven Candidates were admitted, one only, Percy James Exton, succeeded in passing in the whole of the subjects required for Matriculation.

10. We have been in communication with the Authorities of the Sydney University, and have much pleasure in being able to announce that their sanction has been received to local examinations for Matriculation being held in Hobart under our supervision. Such examinations will be held annually, beginning on the first Monday in March.

Sydney University Matriculation Examination.

11. An examination for the Scholarship of £100 per annum for three years, offered by the Trustees of the Gilchrist Educational Trust to the youth of this Colony, was held under our supervision, beginning on Monday, the 30th July last. Two candidates presented themselves,—viz., Francis Sydney Knight and John Joseph Macnamara. Both Candidates passed in the First Division; the latter, however, being superior in merit, was the successful competitor. This was the final examination under the old conditions.

Gilchrist Scholarship Examination.

The first examination under the new conditions—i.e., annual examination open to any of the Australian Colonies—was held on the 4th February last, Mr. Ernest C. Fincham being the only Candidate.

In connection with these examinations the authorities of the University desire it to be made known “that all Candidates who pass the examination will thereby become members of this University, and that having once passed they cannot again present themselves for Matriculation, consequently such of them as pass without gaining a Scholarship cannot compete for one again at any future Matriculation examination.”

The first local examination for Matriculation at the London University was held under our supervision in February last. Only one Candidate presented himself, but we have not yet been advised with what result.

London University Matriculation Examination.

12. A doubt having arisen whether the Degree of Associate of Arts could be legally conferred upon any Student not a resident of this Colony, we sought and obtained the opinion of the Crown Law Officers on the point. The opinion is as follows:—

A.A. Degree.

“There is nothing in the Act, 22 Victoria No. 21, restricting the examination for the A.A. Degree to ‘youth of Tasmania,’ nor is there any residential qualification as there is with regard to the Tasmanian Scholarships.

“The Council has power—see Sect. 8—to confer the Degree of Associate of Arts on all students passing satisfactory examination.”

13. Three vacancies occurred in the Council during the year, two by the retirement of His Honor Mr. Justice Dobson and the Rev. W. H. Savigny, under the operation of Section 9 of the Council’s Rules and Regulations, and one by the decease of the Hon. T. D. Chapman. The first-named gentleman was unanimously re-elected; the Right Reverend the Bishop of Tasmania was elected in the room of the Rev. W. H. Savigny, and the Venerable Archdeacon Davenport in the room of the Hon. T. D. Chapman.

Vacancies in Council.

We desire to place on record in this Report the following Resolution unanimously agreed to by us:—

“The Council desires to express its regret at the loss it has sustained by the death of the Honorable Thomas Daniel Chapman, and to record its high appreciation of his past services as a Member of the Council, and of the efficient support he ever rendered to the cause of higher education in the Legislature.”

14. We have repeatedly had under consideration the question of the establishment of a Tasmanian University. Additional experience has confirmed the opinion we have expressed in previous years, that it is eminently desirable that the Legislature should sanction the creation of such an University. We shall have the honor to submit for the consideration of Your Excellency a special report upon this important subject.

15. We submit a Statement of the Disbursements of the Council between the 1st January and the 31st December, 1883, the termination of the financial year, together with a Supplementary Statement of Payments between the 1st January and the 30th April, 1884. The total expenditure under every head for the year 1883 is shown to have amounted to £2114 19s. 1d.

Financial Statement.

16. We append to our Report a Roll of the Tasmanian Scholars, a List of those Students who have obtained the Degree of Associate of Arts, and a List of those who obtained Exhibitions offered by the Council.
