

REPORT OF THE DEVON COTTAGE HOSPITAL, 1889.

I HAVE the honor to report as follows :---

The Hospital was formally opened on 26th January, 1889, and the first patient admitted on 4th February.

The Board of Governors are incorporated under "The Charitable Institutions Act."

42 patients were admitted; 27 discharged, cured; 9 much benefited; 1 improved; 1 no better; 2 died; 2 remain under treatment. 16 were accident cases.

A strenuous effort has been made to establish the nucleus of a "Repair and Maintenance Fund," with the following objects:—(1.) The meeting of any sudden demand upon the resources of the Hospital. (2.) The maintenance of the fabric in good repair. (3.) The providing for such additions to the buildings or appliances as may be found necessary for the efficiency of the Hospital.
