

The Contracts for works under the Tenders of Wm. Blyth, reported upon in August, 1869, were rendered up in December last, and the road completed from Bridport to 16 chains beyond the Ringarooma River, a distance of about 29 miles.

PATERSONIA AND RINGAROOMA ROAD.

My previous Report set forth that to complete the unfinished 16 miles of road, including bridges and culverts, between Scottsdale and Springfield and towards Patersonia, to the $8\frac{1}{2}$ miles already constructed, is estimated to cost, if 20 feet wide, £5000; if 15 feet wide, £3,700; and to bridge the Ringarooma River where it intersects the roadways, and construct approaches, is estimated at £700 to £750.

WEST TAMAR ROAD.

Messrs. Hay & Co.'s contracts, referred to in my previous Report, were completed in October last.

The slabbing of the section commencing near the 16th mile and terminating 4 chains west of Blackfish Creek, a distance of 2 miles and 16 chains, has been completed; also, the forming, draining, culverting, and slabbing of the other portions of road to Victoria. This has been done by day labour, under the immediate supervision of the Department.

A party of stonebreakers have been and are still employed procuring metal for the slabbed portion of road between Leslie and the Huon River.

Blinding has been procured and spread between the 16th and 18th miles for a distance of one mile, at 8s. per chain, and at 7s. 6d. per chain for 63 chains, under the tender of Charles Oates.

The tender of James Cousins has also been accepted for further blinding for a distance of about 2 miles at 7s. 9d. per chain.

The metal has been carted under the tender of James Cousins at 2s. 3d. per cubic yard, from the quarry near the road leading to Vince's southerly to Bartels, from the quarry near the 17th mile from Hobart Town northerly to Bartels, and from the same and other quarries southerly to 20 chains beyond the Blackfish Creek.

For Completion of Road from Port Esperance to Southport.

Out of the Vote of £3500 for this work £2000 was transferred by 33 Vict. No. 17 to Huon Road, leaving £1500 available.

Alfred Hall and a party of bushmen have been employed in repairing the slab road and in clearing and cutting a track from the termination of the Southport Road towards Port Esperance. Expended, £182 9s. 9d.

FOR WORKS IN THE COUNTIES OF DEVON AND WELLINGTON.

For the Construction of a Road from the River Leven to the River Blythe.

Under 31 Vict. No. 23. Vote, £2400. And under 33 Vict. No. 17. Votes, £1000 and £2300.

The additional section of one mile and 25 chains under Ritchie, Watson, and Co.'s contract was completed in September last, and the following contracts have since been entered into:—

For forming, metalling, gravelling, and other works on the $8\frac{1}{4}$ miles of road or thereabouts between the River Leven and Preservation Bay, under the Tender of G. C. Brooke, at £1384, and there has been authorised for additional metalling on this part of road £106.

This work has been almost completed, and will be taken over early in September.

The clearing, forming, and other works commencing near the Beach on the west side of Preservation's Bay, passing through Adam's land and along the reserve in front of Nash's land, a distance of 36 chains; also 18 chains in front of M'Kenna's land under Tender of James Fenton, at £172 18s.; and for breaking stone and blinding about 22 chains at ends of larger section for the sum of £20; also for falling, cutting up, and removing trees leaning over the road beyond the cleared 30 feet, £15 1s., have been completed.

The clearing, forming, draining, bridging, putting in culverts, &c. on three additional sections from Preservation Bay to Emu Bridge, under Tender of C. B. M. Fenton, at £654 10s., are being proceeded with; and his Tender has also been accepted for such of the following works as may be ordered in writing by the Director of Public Works, at the prices stated:—

For cutting down trees beyond the 66 feet clearing, from 12 in. to 24 in. diameter, at 5s. each tree. Ditto, 24 in. to 36 in. diameter, at 7s. each tree. Ditto, 36 in. and upwards, at 10s. each tree.

For cutting extra drains, at 7s. per chain. For constructing extra culverts, at £10 each.

For constructing Bridges and clearing Tracks between Table Cape, Circular Head, and the Duck River. Vote £6000.

Bridge over the River Inglis.

The Tender of Messrs. Humphreys, Roe, & Co. at £586 19s. has been accepted for the erection of a pile and corbel bridge of three spans of 40 feet each carried by trusses. Each pile pier is to be braced with diagonal braces, and the shore ends carried by log trestles and corbels. The underside of beams is 5 feet above highest flood level. The platform or roadway is 12 feet wide in the clear, and protection afforded by fence on each side. Also, for such of the under-mentioned works as may be ordered in writing by the Director of Public Works, at the prices stated:—

For cutting on one side of bridge and filling to embankment on the other, including forming, at 1s. 7d. cubic yard.

For cutting and wheeling to spoil, as may be directed, at 1s. per cubic yard.

For digging from adjoining land and wheeling to embankment, at 1s. 5d. per cubic yard. For constructing drains, at 7s. 6d. per chain.

Bridge over Big Creek.

The Tender of William Peart and Son at £603 has been accepted for erecting a trestle bridge with log piers at shore ends, centre span 50 feet carried by trusses, shore spans 22 feet and 24 feet; extreme length of bridging 140 feet; the under side of beams is 30 feet above the bed of river, width of platform 12 feet in the clear, with protecting fence on each side. Also, including cuttings and forcings at approaches to Bridge.

The works at both Bridges are in a fair state of progress.

Mr. Surveyor Simmons has also been instructed to survey a line of road to connect that surveyed by Mr. Dooley between Table Cape and Circular Head with the Bridge over the Detention River, as well as a deviation between the 8th and the 10th miles, preparatory to inviting Tenders for clearing it.

For Road from Ulverstone to Gunn's Plains. Vote £8000.

The Contracts of M'Donald and Fogg for Section 1; Ritchie, Watson, and Co. for Section 2; and J. A. Fogg for Section 3, as set forth in my previous Report, have since been completed.

Mr. Firth has been engaged in laying out a road into Gunn's Plains—this portion of Castra being inaccessible from the present road;—and labourers have been employed cutting same to enable tenders to be invited for clearing and forming the line, which has been opened for horse and foot traffic for a distance of $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles, leaving $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles yet to be cut to the Plains. This route will be shorter than the original line as marked by Mr. Dooley by $2\frac{3}{4}$ miles, and will pass through and give access to a considerable quantity of crown land.

Tenders were invited in March last for clearing, draining, culverting, and forming road from the north-west corner of Bennett's 100 acres to Board of Works line near Latrobe, that of Wm. Andrews at £400 for clearing road 50 feet wide, and grubbing track for a width of 25 feet, has been accepted; also for cutting drains at 5s. per chain.

For building and putting in culverts, including approaches and gravelling, at £8 each.

For excavating and removing to a distance not exceeding two chains, to be measured in the cutting, at 2s. per cubic yard.

The works are progressing.

UNDER PUBLIC BUILDINGS ACT, 31 VICT. No. 24.

For new Buildings, and for the purchase of Premises for the Asylum, New Norfolk. Under 31 Vict. No. 24,—Vote £2300; and under 33 Vict. No. 16,—Vote £500.

The Contracts of George Green for new Building for female paying patients, for fitting up closets with drains, pipes, &c., and for supplying and erecting dividing fence with gates, as set forth in my previous Report, have been completed; also for alterations to boundary wall, and furnishing iron railing and stone coping, at a cost of £144 15s. 0d.

Tenders were invited in March last for repairs to and re-shingling roofs of old buildings, flagging, and new gates, &c. The Governor, on the recommendation of the Commissioners of Lunacy, approved of that of George Green at £590 being accepted: the shingles and hardwood timber to be provided by the Government.

For Buildings for Watch-houses and for the use of the Police throughout the Colony. Under 31 Vict. No. 24. Vote £1000.—Under 32 Vict. No. 22. Vote £1000.—Under 33 Vict No. 16. Vote £1000.

In addition to the Police Buildings completed as set forth in last Report, the Watch-house, Leslie, New Huon Road, and the Police Buildings, Scottsdale, therein referred to, have been finished; and the following Contracts entered into.

For preparing and building in frame (the Government finding the hardwood timber only, the Contractor finding all soft wood, glass, ironmongery, &c.), and taking down and packing up for shipment, Police Buildings for Waterhouse, under the Tender of Rigby and Roffey.

The work has been performed at a cost of £151 1s. For like work for residence for Stipendiary Magistrate and Commissioner, Waterhouse, under Tender of William Stone, at a cost of £94 19s.

The framing, woodwork, and materials for the above-mentioned buildings were taken to the Tomahawk per Seymour and Tasman, and landed there under the Tender of O. H. Hedberg at £145 10s.

The Tender of R. M. White at £207 for carting from the Tomahawk and erecting on site pointed out by the Commissioner, Police Buildings, at Waterhouse (the Contractor finding all labour, nails, sand, bricks, &c.), has been accepted.

Also the Tender of Nichols and Irwin at £198 for like work for residence of Stipendiary Magistrate and Commissioner, Waterhouse. All but completed.

The Police Station at the River Picton, Huon, consisting of one room, 14ft. 6in. \times 12ft.; one 12ft. \times 9ft. $4\frac{1}{2}$ in.; one 14ft. 6in. \times 9ft.; and one 9ft. $4\frac{1}{2}$ in. \times 9ft., with verandah 25ft. \times 6ft., under Tender of Patrick Hill at £100, has been completed except the chimney, for which £10 has been retained till it is built of approved materials.

A boat 15 feet long, 4ft. 6in. beam, clinker built, copper fastened, with seats, &c., complete, and a pair of 10 feet paddles, for police purposes at the Picton, has been supplied under Tender of Patrick Hill at £15.

For cutting Tracks through Crown Lands with the view of rendering them available for settlement, under 31 Vict. No. 24. Vote £2000.—Under 33 Vict. No. 17. Vote £2000.

In addition to the Works set forth in my previous Report, the following have been carried out.

Marking out and clearing a track 6 feet in width from the Fingal District to Waterhouse, commencing at a place fordable on the South Esk, between that River and the Government Road, Ringarooma River, and from the point where the Arnon passes over the road between Ringarooma and Scottsdale, near the crossing over the "Great Forester," to its intersection with the track from Tucker's Corner, Scottsdale, to Waterhouse, under Tender of Charles Gould at a cost of £323 1s.

A track from the Huon Road, near the 15th milestone from Hobart Town, towards the Mountain River, into good land, has been cut by Alfred Hall and men accustomed to bush work.

A track from the Springs to the Den, a distance of about 5 miles, commencing at the site for Police Buildings, Springs, crossing 3 creeks in the first mile, and then along a dry ridge to the Den, has been cleared of scrub, logs, stumps, and timber, to a width of 6 feet, and the trees well blazed; also five bridges or culverts 6 feet wide, well secured, have been constructed and completed under Tender of Joel C. Hurst at £20, who has also cleared and cut a track 6 feet wide, including culverts, &c., from the Back Creek to the Springs, a distance of 6 miles, at a cost of £25.

A track is also being cleared suitable for foot and horse traffic, starting from the south bank of the River Huon, near the junction of the Russell River, and extending to the River Craycroft, crossing the Rivers Arve and Picton, under Tender of Samuel Buxton, at £11 per mile.

For the Bonding Warehouse, Hobart Town. Vote £2400.

Payment was made to John Read in October last for the Works under his Contract set forth in myprevious Report, after deductions to the extent of £24 4s. 6d. for Works not properly executed.

The Works throughout interior of Store No. 1, reported in course of performance by prison labour, have been completed.

William Ware has, under his Tender at £1274 for taking off roof of old building fronting on Macquarie-street, and for alterations and repairs to same; also for the erection of an additional Store of two floors, length 99 feet, width 26 feet, height 23 feet, with a verandah for gauging purposes 99 feet × 14 feet, satisfactorily completed his Contract.

Tenders were invited in May for stone piers, brickwork, entrance gates, &c. That of John Anderson at £200 was accepted, and the work has been satisfactorily performed.

Additional works, lift with counterpoise weights, iron rollers, chains, rods, &c., and other petty repairs are bordering on completion.

The Stores are now available for Bonding purposes.

PUBLIC WORKS ACT, 33 VICT. No. 16.

For the construction of Jetties at Bridport and the Tomahawk; a Bridge over the Great Forester River; a Road from Bridport to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse; and a Road from the Landing Place at the Tomahawk to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse; and also a Track from Tucker's Corner to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse. Vote £2500.

The Tender of Edwin Cummings for the under-mentioned works on road between Tomahawk and Waterhouse, was accepted at the prices stated.

For erecting a Bridge over the Sheepwash Creek to a height above all flood waters, and for clearings and making approaches, also gravelling, for the sum of £65 6s. Also, for such clearing and grubbing on the line 33 feet wide and clearing off all trees up to 9 inch diameter, and all fallen timber, 16 feet 6 inches on each side of the 33 feet, at £20 per mile. For constructing drains 3 ft. \times 18 in. \times 15 in. at 8s. per chain; ditto, 4 ft. \times 2 ft. \times 18 in., at 12s. per chain. For log culverts of the following dimensions, including gravelling:—3 ft. \times 2 ft. in the clear opening and 30 ft. long, at £12 each; 5 ft. \times 4 ft. in the clear opening and 30 ft. long, at £16 17s. each. For box culverts 12 in. \times 10 in. inside measurement at 4s. per foot run. For constructing logging across marshy places, logs 22 feet long and at least 9 inches diameter at small end, laid close, curbs at least 4 inches diameter at small end, pinned down on both sides to every third log, at £15 7s. per chain run. For carting and spreading gravel, at 5s. per cubic yard.

Mr. Cummings has been paid for $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles of clearing; 94 chains of drains 3 ft. \times 18 in. \times 15 in.; 107 chains of drains 4 ft. \times 2 ft. \times 18 in.; two log culverts 3 ft. \times 2 ft. \times 30 feet; and one log culvert 5 ft. \times 4 ft. \times 30 ft., the sum of £292 13s.

The other works are still progressing.

Track Tucker's Corner to Waterhouse.

A Track has been cleared and formed for horse traffic from Waterhouse to the Track cut under C. Gould's contract leading to Fingal, including 25 chains of logging, and 2 culverts under offer of John Pearson, at £50.

SORELL CAUSEWAY.

Under Acts 29 Vict. No. 1, and 33 Vict. No. 17.

The works which remained in abeyance since November, 1868, have been resumed.

The under-mentioned Tenders were received on the 7th ultimo by the Trustees appointed by the Government under the provisions of "The Sorell Causeway Act;" viz.—from Cullen and Mackey, at £18,920, time 23 months; William Andrews, at £15,390, time 24 months; Thomas Oldham, at £13,528 10s., time 24 months.

Mr. Thomas Oldham's Tender having been accepted by the Trustees and approved of by the Governor in Council, Messrs. Oldham and Helmer entered into the required Contract for the due prosecution of the works in conformity with the plans and specification attached to the Contract.

The amount of £300 for keeping and maintaining the works for 12 months after the completion is included in the £13,528 10s.

For constructing Roads and Bridges in the Agricultural Area District of George's Bay.

Against the sum of £1000 authorised by Governor in Council to be raised by Debentures for the service stated.

The works under John M'Bean's contract for clearing and forming $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles of road and for erecting bridge over the River Groom, and a bridge over George's River, were completed in February last, at a cost of £253 10s.

John Cunningham and two bushmen have been engaged in marking out the eastern line of road from the Goshen through Rosier's Ford to the Lots in the vicinity of the Northern and Southern Sisters.

Tenders were received in July for additional works on three sections of road Gould's Country, George's Bay, and for the clearing of the eastern road as above mentioned.

That of Isaac Chapple has been accepted for clearing, sidling cutting, and constructing drains and culverts on Section 1, between the George's and Groom Rivers, and from the Groom River to Lot 23, at £34 10s. For sidling cutting, forming, and constructing drains and culverts on Section 2, from the junction of the Groom and Ransom Roads to Letter A on Chart, Lot 5, (A. W. Nichols) and thence to Lot 10, at £45. And for clearing the Eastern Road 8 feet wide on each side of centre pegs from the Goshen Road by Rosier's Ford to the vicinity of the Northern and Southern Sisters, at £2 19s. per mile.

The Tender of A. Johnson has also been accepted for clearing and sidling cutting on Section 3, from Lot 14 to Lot 35, at £70 10s. Also, for such of the under-mentioned works as may be ordered:—

For cutting drains 3 ft. \times 18 in. \times 15 in., at 7s. per chain. Ditto, 4 ft. \times 2 ft. \times 18 in., at 10s. per chain.

For constructing culverts 5 ft. \times 4 ft., at £5 each.

Ditto, 3 ft. × 2 ft., at £3 each.

Line of Road from the George Town Road to Piper's River.

A new Line of Road from the George Town Road to Piper's River joining the present line at Jones' has been marked and pegged out by John Cunningham and labourers employed under him, for a distance of about $8\frac{1}{2}$ miles, and Tenders have been invited for clearing the same.

It will form a portion of the road to Waterhouse, will pass between the Gold Fields at the Den and

the Nine Mile Springs, and open up for settlement a block of rich crown land estimated to contain more than 1000 acres.

The cost of this work will be charged to the reserved sum set apart by the 86th Section of 27 Vict. No. 22, and 20th Section of 31 Vict. No. 25, sale of Crown Lands in the County of Dorset.

GOLD FIELDS.

Nine Mile Springs and Back Creek.

The Tenders of Rutherford and Gill, being the lowest, for the erection at Nine Mile Springs of Hut for Mining Registrar and Telegraph Station at £116 10s. 6d., and for Police Buildings at £130, have been accepted.

The Tender of Andrew Stewart at £65 for the erection of Police Buildings, Back Creek, has also been accepted.

The buildings are in course of erection.

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The cost of the above and other works authorised by the Governor in Council to be charged against the sum of £750 to be provided for the service.

Opening up Roads, &c. between Rivers Mersey and Leven.

The claims of Mr. J. M. Dooley, rendered at £452 17s. 3d. and £5 5s., less £250 paid on account in 1868, referred to in Public Works Report of 24th August, 1869, as having been held over owing to objections taken by this Department that Mr. Dooley had not completed the work, especially in gradients, in conformity with the terms of his Contract, were, with other claims which he preferred against the Survey Department amounting to £932 2s: 10d., submitted to arbitration. As the arbitrator made his award without giving the respective amounts to be charged against each Department, I am unable to report the reduction made on each specific claim; but I may state the entire payment awarded to Mr. Dooley on foot of his aggregate demand of £1140 5s. 1d. was reduced to £758 10s. 6d.
