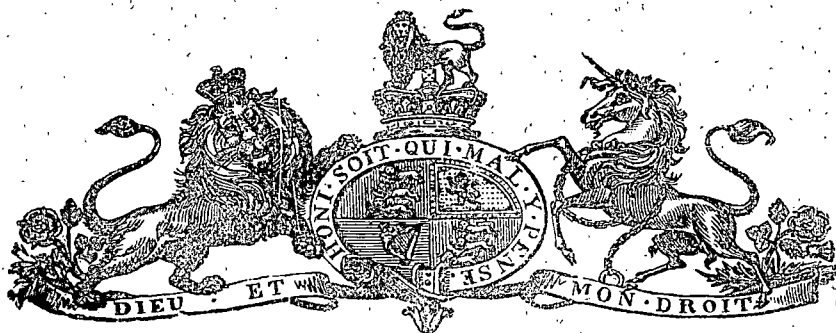

#### NOTICE.

WHEREAS during the year 1865, three lots of land, containing an area of seven acres and twenty-four perches, situate in the Town of Longford, and delineated on the enclosed tracing, were reserved for the Municipality of Longford: And whereas five acres and fifteen perches adjoining were reserved for the Longford Cricket Club: Notice is hereby given that, at the request of the Municipal Council of Longford, it is the intention of the Governor-in-Council, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Section 12, 34 Victoria, No. 10, to vest the whole of the above-mentioned lands in the said Council, as a place for the recreation of the inhabitants of Longford, subject to the conditions contained in the said Act.
