

THE PATERSONIA, BRIDPORT, AND RINGAROOMA ROADS.

Votes-£8400 10s. 11d; and £9850 4s. 10d.

TENDERS were invited and received on the 3rd of March last for clearing, forming, bridging, and other works, commencing at Tucker's Corner and terminating 3 chains south of the River Brid, a distance of 6 miles.

That of John Loone being the lowest, at £781 16s., was accepted; also-

For cutting drains No. 1, 8s. per chain.

Ditto, No. 2, 10s. per chain.

For constructing log culverts, No. 1, £5 each.

Ditto, No. 2, £8 each.

For constructing box culverts, 20 feet long, £3 each.

Ditto, 24 feet long, £3 10s. each.

For cutting down trees from 12 in. to 24 in. diameter, 3s. per tree.

Ditto 24 in. to 36 in. diameter, 5s. per tree.

Ditto 36 in. diameter and upwards, 10s. per tree.

The works have been completed; but, as the Contractor is bound to maintain them for 2 months thereafter, the balance on foot of Contract will not be payable till the end of December.

For constructing Bridges and clearing Tracks between Table Cape, Circular Head, and the Duch River. 31 Vict. No. 23. Vote £6000.

The Bridges over River Inglis and Big Creek, referred to in Report of 23rd August, 1870, have been completed under Tenders of Humphreys, Roe, and Co., and Wm. Peart and Son.

The survey of a line of road to connect that laid out by Mr. Dooley between Table Cape and Circular Head with the Bridge over the Detention River, as well as a deviation between 8th and 10th miles, has also been made; and the Tender of Messrs. Brown, Swain, and Lennard has been accepted for clearing the same, a distance of about $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles, at £78 per mile.

A Contract has also been entered into with Mr. C. B. M. Fenton for works on road between the Inglis Bridge and Jacob's Boat Harbour at £159, and for such of the under-mentioned works as may be ordered at the prices stated to the extent of the balance available on foot of vote:—

For cutting down roadway and filling, at 1s. 4d. per cubic yard. For forming, grading, and gravelling, at £7 per chain. For metalling roadway, at £6 10s. per chain. For constructing culverts, at £5 each. For cutting drains, at 8s. per chain.

The works under these Contracts are progressing.

ROAD FROM ULVERSTONE TO GUNN'S PLAINS (CASTRA).

Vоте-£8000.

After the work of laying out the road to Gunn's Plains already reported upon had been completed, Tenders were invited for clearing and grubbing on the East Castra Line, commencing at the 11th mile peg and extending 5 miles 22 chains as marked into land of Mr. J. A. Fulton, together with branches from the same to the east boundary of land belonging to Mr. W. H. Blowers; and for like work West Castra commencing at the Old Gawler Road and extending to Colonel Fulton's north side line, a distance of 10 miles and 2 chains, and from thence to Major A. Dumbleton's south boundary, a distance of 4 miles.

The Tenders of William Andrews, being the lowest, at £520 and £767, were accepted, and the works are progressing.

Tenders were also invited in May last for clearing and grubbing on branch road, West Castra, commencing at the 5th mile-peg and terminating 77 chains beyond the 12th mile-peg, a distance of 7 miles and 77 chains.

That of William Andrews, at £115 per mile, being the lowest, was accepted for clearing, grubbing, and other works on road to a width of 20 feet, and for cutting down all trees and scrub and other work as per specification to a width of 23 feet on each side of the 20 feet. Works progressing.

There has been erected over the River Gawler, West Castra, under Contract of Joseph Raymond, a Trussed and Corbel Bridge in one span on log abutments. Entire length, 61 feet; clear width, 14 feet; height above highest flood level, 5 feet; with protecting railing and approaches, at a cost of £313 10s.

Four instalments (£400) on account of clearings East and West Castra have been charged against balance of the vote of £8000. To meet further outlay on works a sum of £2500 has been authorised by the Governor in Council to be provided under 18th Section of "The Waste Lands Act," 34 Vict. No. 10.

For the construction of Jetties at Bridport and the Tomahawh; a Bridge over the Great Forester River; a Road from Bridport to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse; and a Road from the Landing-place at the Tomahawh to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse; and also a Track from Tucker's Corner to the Gold Fields at Waterhouse. Vote £2500.

In addition to the works paid for under Contract of Mr. E. Cummings, as set forth in Report of 23rd August, 1870, the following have also been performed:—

116 chains small drains, 12 chains large ditto; 13 box culverts, and 6 log culverts; 21 chains laying tea tree scrub in swamps; and $1026\frac{2}{3}$ cubic yards of forcing.

SORELL CAUSEWAY.

Under Acts 29 Vict. No. 1, and 33 Vict. No. 17.

The works at the Sorell Causeway have been carried on during the past year, and are still being proceeded with under Messrs. Oldham and Helmer's contract.

The road approach and the embankment from the Bluff towards Medway Point were commenced in February last, and considerable progress has been made in carrying out the same. The excavation for the road is of very great depth through a hard sandstone,—an excellent material for forming the embankment.

The timber bridging to connect this embankment with Medway Point has also been proceeded with. The whole of the piles are driven, except those which remain in abeyance, pending decision as to the erection of a draw-bridge. About one-third of the remainder of the timber work on this section is completed.

On the road across Medway Point the slopes have been cut down, and materials obtained for the embankment to the Sorell shore.

The work to the embankments from Medway Point towards the Sorell shore (formed, but not finished under previous contracts) has consisted only of dressing the slopes and making the embankments the full width

The timber bridging on this section is nearly completed; a few rails to the fences, and braces to the piles, only being required.

The embankment from the timber bridging to the Sorell shore has been lately commenced; but as yet little progress has been made thereon.

Messrs. Oldham and Helmer expect to complete their contract by 25th July, 1872.

For defraying the cost of creeting additional Buildings to the Lands and Works Department and the Government Printing Office.—Vote £1500.

The Tender of R. B. Wiggins at £1425 for the above service was accepted in the month of December, 1870; and for foundations with rubble works, at 10s. 6d. per rod; concrete, 7s. per yard.

The buildings have been completed, and the Government Printer's Department removed thereto in August. The consolidated departments of Lands and Works now occupy the old offices.

The expenditure under Wiggins' contract, and removing the Government Printer's Department, and fitting up his offices, is as follows:—

On the 6th of September, Tenders were received for the erection of additional Buildings in accordance with the plans and specification sanctioned by the Government.

That of Mr. R. B. Wiggins at £1632, being the lowest, was accepted, subject to the particulars and conditions of contract affecting the same.

The works have been commenced, and the time within which they are to be completed is as stated in the contract, 31st March, 1872.

For constructing Roads and Bridges in the Agricultural Area District of George's Bay.

Against the sum of £1000 authorised by Governor in Council to be raised by Debentures for the service stated.

Additional works on 3 sections of road, Gould's Country, George's Bay, and clearing portion of the Eastern Road, under Contracts of Isaac Chapple and A. Johnston, have been completed; also clearing away timber and cutting 20 chains of sidling, cutting 20 chains of drains, and constructing 2 culverts on road between George's River Bridge and Groom River Bridge, by Geo. Nichols, at £20; and clearing portion of road 20 feet wide between Goshen and George's River by Isaac Chapple at 1s. 6d. per chain.

Having been instructed by the Government to have the line of road in the Parishes of Malling and Parkham, from junction of Elizabeth Town Road, laid out, cleared, and grubbed, Tenders were invited and received in December, 1870, but not acted on. Alterations were made in the lines and class of work, and fresh Tenders received in April last.

That of John Spicer for clearing, grubbing, and other works for a distance of about 9 miles, at £34 per mile, has been accepted; also for cutting drains at 6s. per chain; for constructing culverts 25 feet long, at £2 10s. each; and for metalling one chain on each side of culverts, at £4 10s. per chain.
