A BILL FOR

**An Act to amend the *Financial Management and Audit Act
1990***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Financial
Management and Audit Amendment Act 2007*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this
Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Financial Management and Audit
Act 1990** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 14(2) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (d) “jointly.” and substituting “jointly; or”;
- (b) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (d):
 - (e) in the case of an appropriation for the Office of the Ombudsman, the Minister administering the *Ombudsman Act 1978*.
