A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Constitution Act 1934

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution* Amendment (House of Assembly Electoral Boundaries) Act 2018.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Constitution Act 1934** is referred to as the Principal Act.
