## **A BILL FOR**

**An Act to validate certain fees collected under the *Crown Lands Act 1976* and other Acts**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Validation of Fees) Act 2011*.

### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on a day to be proclaimed.

### **3. Validation of fees**

Any fees collected or purportedly collected by the Crown under or in connection with the

*Crown Lands Act 1976* or any Act specified in Schedule 1 to that Act before the commencement of this Act are taken to have been validly collected.

**4. Administration of Act**

Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Environment, Parks and Heritage; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment.
