



REPORT of the Board for the Year ending 31st December, 1900.

To the Honourable SIR JOHN STOKELL DODDS, Knight Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Chief Justice, and Administrator in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

In pursuance of "The Fire Brigades Act," 47 Vict. No. 21, this Board has the honour to report as follows:

- 1. The Brigade has maintained its full complement of officers and men, who have attended fires, alarms, and practices as required, and have exhibited the usual efficiency in the duties demanded of them.
 - 2. The Superintendent reports that the plant now in use is in a serviceable condition.
- 3. The number of fires and alarms attended by the Brigade during the year was forty-three, as per annexed Report.
- 4. The Expenditure for the year was £914 14s. 3d., less unclaimed amounts, £2 11s. 3d.; and expenses paid by the owners and occupiers of uninsured property, £14 14s. 7d.: leaving net expenditure, £897 8s. 5d.
 - 5. There have been thirteen meetings of the Board during the year.
