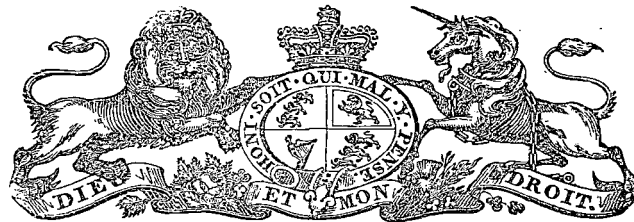

REPORT FOR 1890.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit the following Returns, Nos. 1 to 7, explanatory of the work of this Department for the year 1890:—

1. Return showing the number of items subject to Real Estate Duty, and amount of rateable value of properties, in each District for the years 1885, 1886, 1887, and 1888; and the number of items and capital value of properties in each District for the years 1889 and 1890.
2. Return showing the total number of items subject to Real Estate Duty, and amount of Real Estate Duty, for each District for the year 1888; the amount of Duty collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.
3. Return showing the number of items subject to Land Tax, and amount of Land Tax, for each District for the year 1889; the amount of Tax collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.
4. Return showing the number of items subject to Land Tax, and amount of Land Tax, for each District for the year 1890; the amount of Tax collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.
5. Return showing the number of items and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1888; the amount of Police Rate collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.
6. Return showing the number of items and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1889; the amount of Police Rate collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.
7. Return showing the number of items and amount of Rural Police Rate for each District for the year 1890; the amount of Police Rate collected, and remaining due, on the 31st December, 1890.

Return No. 1 shows an increase in the capital value of the properties in the Island of £210,761, equal to nearly 10 per cent. on the capital value in 1889.

The accounts for the year 1888 have been closed, as all the recoverable amounts had been collected; those for the year 1889 will be closed at an early date, as few of the recoverable items remain uncollected.

Since the 31st December the majority of the recoverable amounts due for Land Tax and Rural Police Rates for the year 1890 have been collected, and the remainder have been placed in the hands of the Law Officers of the Government for collection.

It would considerably facilitate the work of this Department if an amendment was made in Clause 46 of 52 Vict. No. 31, substituting the 31st March for the 30th June as the date up to which notices of change of ownership should be given.

As the law is at present the supplements to the Assessment Books cannot be compiled till after the 1st July; when that is done notice of assessment must be given to the persons interested, who have thirty days within which to appeal, after which the date of holding the Courts (35) has to be fixed, the appeals heard, and the alterations in the Assessment Books initialled before the 1st October, as otherwise the Supplements to the Assessment Books are not available for the collection of the Land Tax for the current year.

Between the 13th August and the 1st October there are only 22 days available to the Judges for holding Appeal Courts, including the time spent in travelling.

It will be obvious that the work of preparing the Supplements must, under the present law, be crowded into a very short and insufficient time, and that it can only be completed within the necessary time when but few Appeal Courts are required.

It would also be an advantage and probable saving of expense if the information required to be given in writing under Clause 46 of the sale of any property was made evidence of such sale, as, at present, if the value is disputed it would be necessary to subpoena the former owner to prove the price given.
