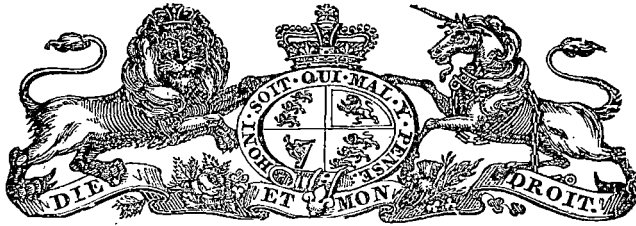

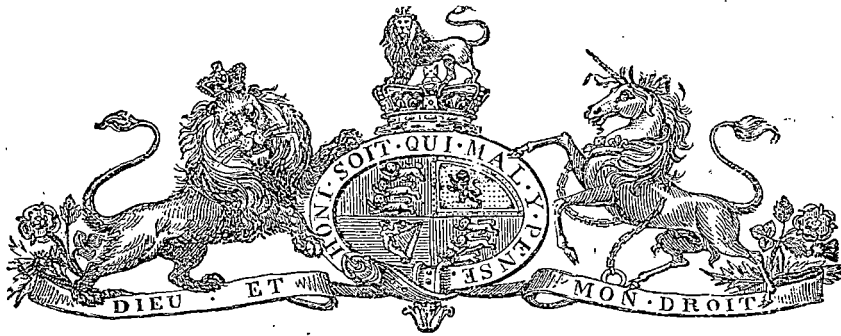

NETTING IN GRANT'S LAGOON, SLOOP ROCK LAGOON, AND BIG LAGOON.

The use of Nets of every description is hereby prohibited in the tidal waters of Grant's Lagoon, in the Parish of Evershot, and Sloop Rock Lagoon and Big Lagoon, in the Parish of Hartlepool, in the County of Dorset, in Tasmania; and any person committing a breach of this Regulation shall for every such offence forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds.
