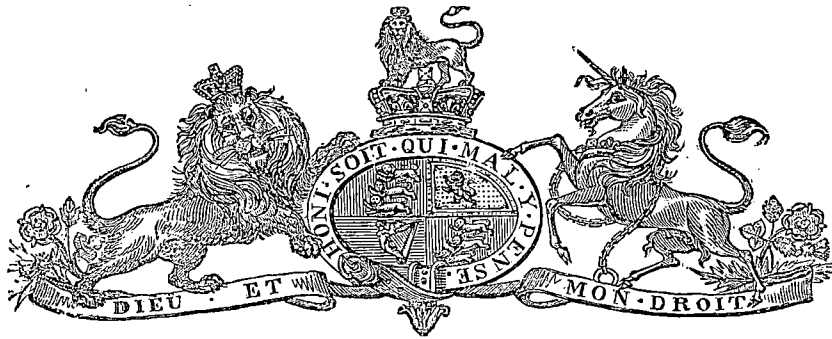

SIR,

I HAVE the honour to submit Tabular Returns of Immigration during the half-year ending 31st December, 1856, numbered from 1 to 6.

2. Subjects requiring particular attention having been specially submitted, as occasion arose, during the half-year, I presume it to be unnecessary to occupy the attention of the Government with a repetition of these.

3. The demand for labour and the rates of wages continue much the same as particularised in my Report for the preceding half-year.
