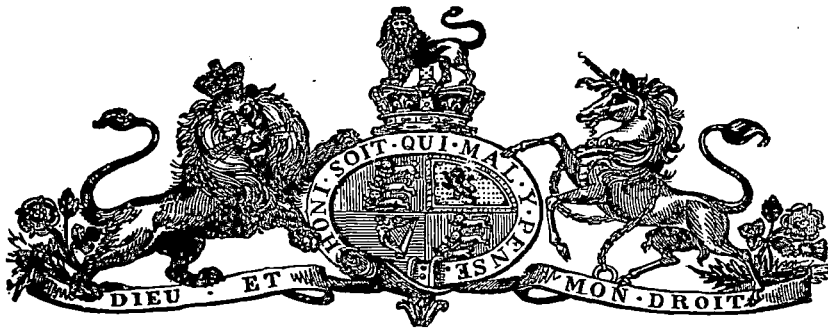

"THE CODLIN MOTH ACT, 1887."

IN pursuance of "The Codlin Moth Act, 1887," the Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

That the sum of Five Pence per acre shall be fixed as the amount to be contributed by each district proclaimed as a Fruit District under the said Act, towards the salary of the Chief Inspector appointed under and for the purposes of the said Act.

That the amount of such contribution be payable for the year ending on the 31st December next, and paid on the 1st day of November, 1888.
