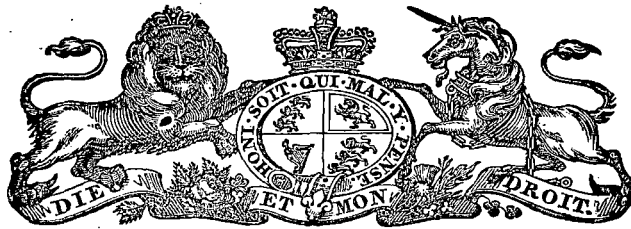

Electric Telegraph Department, 20th May, 1881.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to furnish the Annual Returns and Report on the working of the Electric Telegraph Department for the year ending the 31st December, 1880.

A comparison of the Returns with those of 1879 gives the following results:—

1. An increase of 992 messages and £1318 15s. on the gross receipts.
2. An increase on Tasmanian fees paid into the Treasury of—from business within the Colony, £779 12s. 11d.—Intercolonial and Foreign traffic, £3 11s. 3d.; total increase, £783 4s. 2d.
3. Fees paid to Submarine Cable Company an increase of £58 15s. 3d.
4. Fees paid to other Colonies on account of Intercolonial and European business an increase of £476 16s. 9d.

A comparative statement of the Receipts for the last five years is also furnished.

The only extension during the year has been from George's Bay to Gould's Country, 14 miles. An Office has also been opened at Hastings on the Huon line.

The Submarine Cable between Tasmania and Victoria has worked uninterruptedly during the year.

The working of the Low Heads Station by the staff of the Eastern Extension Telegraph Company at that place gives every satisfaction.

The increase on the Inter-Tasmanian business is very gratifying, but not so as regards the Intercolonial traffic. Although the Submarine Cable Company's receipts show an increase of £58 15s. 3d. over 1879, there is a decrease as against 1878 of £963 19s. 11d. I think a reduction of the Cable charges would tend to popularise this means of communication, and result in increased traffic and revenue.

In July, 1880, the operator at Falmouth, on the East Coast, was supplied with a good telescope, and has regularly since supplied reports of passing vessels, proving a great convenience to the shipping community of this port. Up to the 31st December there have been reported, 33 steamers, 10 ships or barques, 3 brigs, and 41 schooners and other small craft.

The system of "Maintenance" in short sections was abandoned, owing to the difficulty experienced in getting persons to undertake the work. The lines have now been let in larger sections for a period of three years, under stringent conditions, and I am in hopes in a short time of seeing them in good working order and kept so; but I must press upon the Government the necessity of incessant and competent practical supervision, in order to ensure that all clauses of the contract are faithfully carried out.

I would respectfully draw your attention to the steady increase of telegraphic communication and business throughout the Island, and to point out the need of better offices both at Hobart and Launceston. I trust this matter will receive your earnest attention, and that steps will be taken at an early date to provide the accommodation so urgently needed.

Telephonic communication has been established and in daily use with Mount Nelson Station since the 15th September, proving an easy and efficient mode of transmission. Government House has also been connected with the Head Office by Telephone, and working very successfully.

This mode of communication is now extensively used in Melbourne; and I think the Government would do well to foster its introduction into Tasmania, as, apart from private lines which might be erected and maintained by the Government and leased to persons requiring them at a fair rental, use might be made of it for telegraphic business on short lines in many ways, which would prove a valuable auxiliary to the ordinary telegraphic system.
