

REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1882.

Campbell Town, January, 1883.

SIR,

WE have the honor to forward the Annual Report of the Campbell Town Hospital for 1882.

On again meeting the subscribers, your Trustees are in a position to assure you that the advantages to the public of the Campbell Town Hospital during the past year have been duly appreciated. The financial state of the Institution is good, owing in a great measure to the inauguration of "Hospital Sunday."

- 2. The more generous scale of diet adopted since last Report has given unqualified satisfaction.
- 3. We cannot allow this opportunity to pass without placing on record the regard and esteem in which we held the late Mrs. Raiker, thus early removed from us by death. Your Trustees have been fortunate in securing the services of an efficient substitute in the person of her niece, Miss B. Davidson.
- 4. Number of cases treated, 53; of which 4 have died, 2 remain for treatment, the remainder were discharged.
- 5. We request the Clergy will accept of our acknowledgments for their kind ministrations to the sick of this Establishment during the past year,—not forgetting their zeal in the matter of "Hospital Sunday."
- 6. The buildings being much in need of repair—the ceilings giving way in places—their unsuitable nature for the purposes of a Hospital will be brought before you with a view to the whole question occupying your very serious consideration.
  - 7. The triennial appointment of Trustees takes place to-day.
