

PENSIONS, &c.:

ORDERS OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER THE SUPERANNUATION ACT.

Laid upon the Table by the Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, October 29, 1875.



ORDERS of the Governor in Council made under "The Superannuation Act" since the last Meeting of Parliament.

MONDAY, AUGUST 9, 1875.

MINUTE No. 217.

The Colonial Secretary submits that John Lynskey, Petty Constable in the District of Hobart, having been allowed to retire from the public service on account of his inability any longer to perform his duties, he be granted a Superannuation Allowance of £33 12s. 11d. per annum.

His Excellency approves. The allowance to commence as on the 1st instant, and the amount for 1875 to be placed on a Supplementary Estimate.

William Walshe, formerly Second Class District Constable, who retired from the service of the Government under medical certificate, is also granted a Pension of £29 14s. 7d. per annum.

To have effect from the 1st November, 1874, inclusively: the amount for 1874 and 1875 to be placed on Supplementary Estimates.
