THE SELECT COMMITTEE appointed, on the 2nd February, 1858, to consider the propriety of vesting the GOVERNMENT DOMAIN in Trustees for the Use and Recreation of the People, with power to enquire and report upon the Trusts upon which the Land should be so held, have agreed to the following

REPORT.

Your Committee are of opinion that the boundaries of the Domain should be included within the line marked *red* in the Plan which has been submitted to the Committee; and that the Domain be vested in Trustees, consisting of—

The Members of Parliament for the City,

The Mayor of the City,

The Colonial Treasurer, and

The Surveyor-General,

with power to appropriate a certain portion to a Public Cemetery, and to sell the part outside the red line coloured *yellow*, with the exception of the portion occupied by the Government House and by the Royal Society; and to lease such parts within the *red* line as are coloured *pink* on the Map: the proceeds of the Sales and Leases to be appropriated to the maintenance and improvement of the Domain for the Public.
