

REPORT for the Year ending 30 June, 1864.

THE Trustees of the Campbell Town Hospital have the honor to present to the Subscribers their Annual Report for the financial year ending 30th June, 1864.

There has been no alteration in any of the Officers connected with the Hospital during the past year.

The attendance of the Medical Officer, Dr. Valentine, has, as heretofore, been most regular, and his attention to the Patients indefatigable.

To the Clergy of the District are due the thanks of the Subscribers and Trustees for their frequent visits, and the deep interest shown by them in the spiritual welfare of the Patients.

The duties of the Master and Matron have been performed in a most satisfactory manner; and the Trustees have to commend them for their careful attention to the Patients, as well as their economical management of the stores and provisions entrusted to their care.

The Trustees have again the satisfaction of exhibiting a Balance-sheet showing the prosperity of the Establishment; and, although the subscriptions have come in liberally, the Trustees hope that the large amount of benefit expended upon the working classes, especially as shown by the Tabular Statement, will induce new subscribers, as well as those whose subscriptions are in arrear, to come forward in so liberal a manner as not only will ensure the Government aid for the current year, but increase those benefits.
