## A BILL FOR

An Act to confirm the validity of certain transitional regulations made under the *Passenger Transport Act 1997* 

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **Short title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Passenger Transport* (*Transitional Regulations Validation*) Act 2002.

## **Commencement**

**2.** This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
