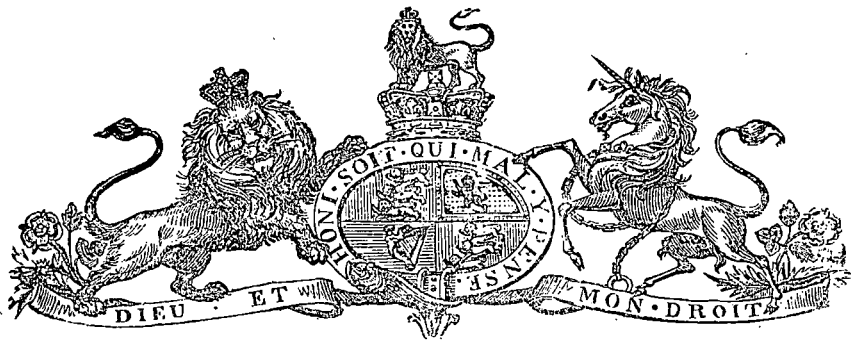

SALMON ACT:

AMENDED REGULATIONS.

December 12, 1872.



GOVERNMENT NOTICE.

No. 112.

Colonial Secretary's Office, 7th October, 1872.

ON the recommendation of the Salmon Commissioners, the Governor in Council has been pleased to approve of the Regulations made under "The Salmon Act" and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 29th August, 1871, being rescinded, and of the following Regulations being made in lieu thereof.

By His Excellency's Command,

JAMES MILNE WILSON.

No person shall fish or take fish in any manner in the Sorell Rivulet, being a tributary of the River Derwent, or in the Bagdad Rivulet, or in the Meredith Rivulet, or in the Kermadie River in Tasmania, under a penalty of Ten Pounds for each breach of this Regulation. And no person shall fish or take fish in any manner in the River Plenty in Tasmania, before the 1st day of October, 1871, under a penalty of Ten Pounds for each breach of this Regulation.

All nets and other engines, instruments, or devices used for taking fish in the above-mentioned Rivers or Rivulets shall be seized and forfeited, destroyed, or removed as each case may require.

It shall be lawful for any person to use a seine net, with meshes measuring two inches and one half of an inch from knot to knot when wet, for the purpose of taking fish in the River Derwent, after such person shall have obtained a certificate under the hand of the Chairman of the Salmon Commissioners setting forth that such seine net has been examined by the Salmon Commissioners.

No person shall be allowed to use any other net for the purpose of fishing in the waters of the River Derwent or any of its tributaries above a line extending from the northern point of the Hobart Town Cemetery on the western to the point at the southern side of Gielston Bay on the eastern bank of the said River, under a penalty of Ten Pounds for each breach of this Regulation.

All nets used in contravention of the foregoing Regulations shall be seized and forfeited, destroyed, or removed as each case may require.
