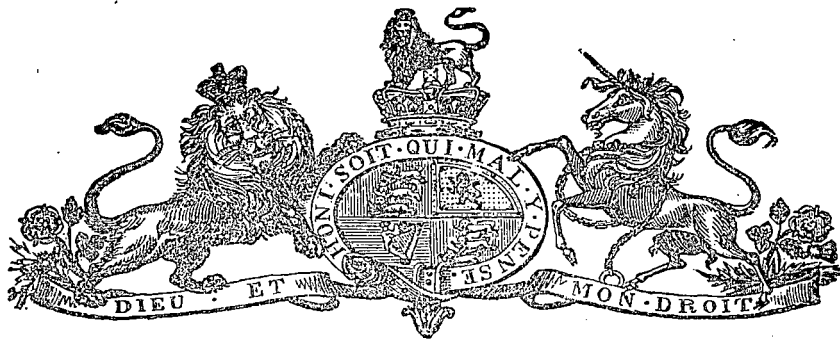

And further, that the Traffic Receipts during the year 1874 amounted to £1044 13s. 1d. in excess of the receipts for the year 1873; the Traffic Receipts for the year 1875 were £1293 1s. 5d. in excess of the receipts for the year 1873; while the Traffic Receipts for the year 1876 were less by £1040 5s. 7d. than the receipts for the year 1875.
