The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House:—

STRAHAN MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a Loan of One hundred and fifty Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost of purchase and improving the Public Recreation Ground. It was resolved to recommend the granting of the loan.

DEVONPORT MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a Loan of Six thousand five hundred Pounds, for Lighting Purposes. The Committee resolved to recommend the granting of the loan, with a sinking fund of two per cent.
