**A BILL FOR**

**An Act to amend the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000***

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Holidays Amendment (Central Coast Municipality) Act 2026*.

**2. Commencement**

This Act commences on 1 January 2027.

**3. Principal Act**

In this Act, the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000*\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

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**4. Section 3 amended (Interpretation)**

Section 3(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting before the definition of *public notice* the following definition:

***agreed day***, in relation to a person who is employed by an employer to work in a municipal area that is not entitled under Schedule 1 to a show day as a statutory holiday, means a day that –

- (a) is a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or other statutory holiday; and
- (b) is agreed by the employee and the employer as a statutory holiday for the employee;

**5. Schedule 1 amended (Statutory Holidays)**

Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is amended by inserting after item 10 in Part 1 the following item:

**6. Repeal of Act**

This Act is repealed on the first anniversary of the day on which it commences.
