

## PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA

## RESOLUTIONS RELATING TO CUSTOMS DUTIES: PROCEDURE OF PARLIAMENT.

Ordered by the Legislative Council to be printed, July 11, 1888.

Volume XVI., House of Assembly Journals: Votes and Proceedings, Wednesday, 19th August, 1868. House passed Resolutions "towards raising the Supply."

The Legislative Council was sitting on the same day, but did not receive the Resolution until Friday, the 21st August. This Resolution was not agreed to by the Council until Tuesday, September 1. (Volume XIV., Legislative Council Journals: Votes and Proceedings, Friday, 21st August, 1868.)

Volume XIX., House of Assembly Journals: Votes and Proceedings, Tuesday, 13th September, 1870. House passed Resolution "towards raising the Supply."

The Legislative Council was sitting on the same day, but did not receive the Resolution until Wednesday, 14th September. Resolution considered and agreed to forthwith. (Volume XV., Legislative Council Journals: Votes and Proceedings, 14th September, 1870.)

Volume XXV., House of Assembly Journals: Votes and Proceedings, Tuesday, 1st July, 1873. House passed Resolution.

The Legislative Council was sitting on the 1st July, but the Resolution was not sent up, and the concurrence of the Council was not sought upon the Resolution, nor until the Bill was forwarded on the 15th July. (Legislative Council Journals, Volume XIX.: Votes and Proceedings, 15th July, 1873.)

Volume XXVI., House of Assembly Journals: Votes and Proceedings, Tuesday, 13th January, 1879. House passed Resolution.

The Legislative Council was sitting on the 13th January, and, having adjourned until 9.30, received and passed the Resolutions.

Volume X., Journals of Parliament: Votes and Proceedings, House of Assembly, Wednesday, 20th July, 1887. House passed Resolution for increased duties on certain articles.

The Legislative Council was not sitting on 20th July, but received and passed the Resolution two days later, viz., Friday, 22nd July. (Legislative Council Votes and Proceedings, Friday, 22nd July.)

In 1874, 1875, 1880, 1883, 1884, and 1885, Bills were received from the House of Assembly without any previous Resolutions.
