

METROPOLITAN DRAINAGE BOARD.

REPORT for the Year ending 31st December, 1892.

To His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, in Council.

Sir,

SIR, THE Metropolitan Drainage Board, constituted under the Act 55 Vict. No. 27, held its first meeting on the 22nd January, 1892. Steps were then taken for the survey of the area placed under the jurisdiction of the Board. A preliminary triangulation of the whole area was made, and a skeleton plan, showing details of the streets, &c. to be drained, is in course of preparation. The Report of the Consulting Engineer, Mr. A. Mault, attached hereto (see Parliamentary Paper, No. 127, 1892), shows the systems of drainage now under the consideration of the Board.

An Act of Parliament (56 Vict. No. 27) was passed during last Session altering the constitution of the Board, which is now being re-organised in compliance therewith.

A Statement of the Accounts of the Board to 31st December, 1892, is attached hereto.
