



REPORT of the Launceston Fire Brigade Board for the Year 1887.

To His Excellency SIR ROBERT GEORGE CROOKSHANK HAMILTON, K.C.B., Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Tasmania.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

In pursuance of "The Fire Brigades Act," 47 Vict. No. 21, this Board has the honor to report as follows:—

#### Brigade Staff.

The Brigade Staff, which consists of Superintendent, Deputy, and twenty-three Firemen, have shown their usual activity when called upon for duty. The average attendance at fires and practices has been satisfactory.

#### Plant.

This is reported to be in fair working order; but it is proposed, during the current year, to add to it by the purchase of a quantity of new hose.

#### Fires.

The Brigade has attended during the year 13 fires and 16 alarms, particulars of which, as usual, are given in the accompanying Report of the Superintendent. In addition to their ordinary duties, several members of the Brigade, with the Deputy Superintendent, rendered valuable assistance in extinguishing a fire which occurred on board the T. S. N. Company's s.s. Flinders, at George Town, which was suitably recognised by the Directors of that Company.

#### Expenditure.

The expenditure for the year has been £545 14s. 9d.

### Meetings and General.

Eleven meetings of the Board have been held during the year. Mr. Weedon, representing the Insurance Companies in Launceston, and Mr. Alderman Sutton, representative of the Municipal Council, were re-elected members of the Board.
