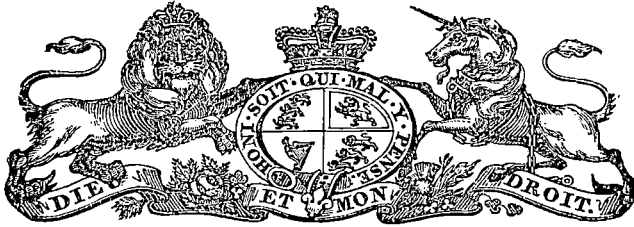

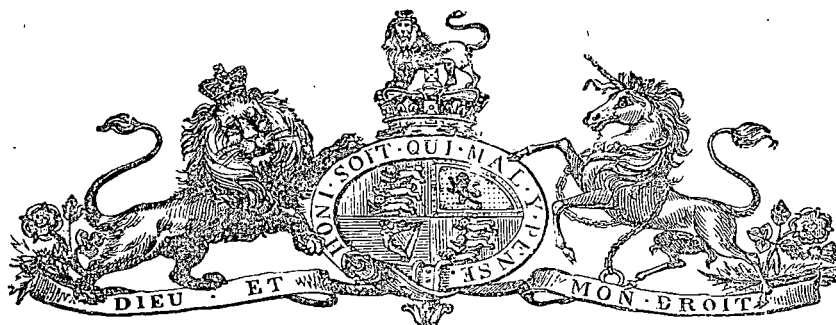

Out of the admissions for the year, 17 patients were treated for the first time.

*Birth-place and Religion of Inmates.*

Thirty-one were natives of Tasmania, and one a native of Ireland. Twenty were Protestants, and twelve were Roman Catholics.

*Ages.*

The average was 21 years; the youngest was 14 years, and the eldest 41 years.
