

HOBART FIRE BRIGADE BOARD:

REPORT FOR 1890.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



REPORT of the FIRE BRIGADE BOARD for the City of HOBART for the Year ending 31st December, 1890, made pursuant to Clause 13 of "The Fire Brigades Act, 1883."

DURING the Year 1890 the Brigade attended 19 fires, being an increase of 5 fires as compared with the previous year. The Board have to report that the men composing the Brigade have performed their duties in a most satisfactory manner.

The balance of expenditure during the same period, after the deduction of the amounts recovered for services rendered on uninsured premises, and sums unclaimed for assistance rendered, amounts to $\pounds 730$ 7s. 6d., which has been equally divided between the Government, the Corporation, and the Insurance Companies.

An account of the Receipts and Expenditure is attached to this Report.

During the year a new hose reel, with appliances, has been purchased and stationed on Lansdowne Crescent. It is contained in a shed which the Corporation have allowed the Board to occupy at a nominal rental.

The Brigade consists of 1 Superintendent and 18 firemen of all ranks.

Eighteen meetings of the Board have been held during the year.
