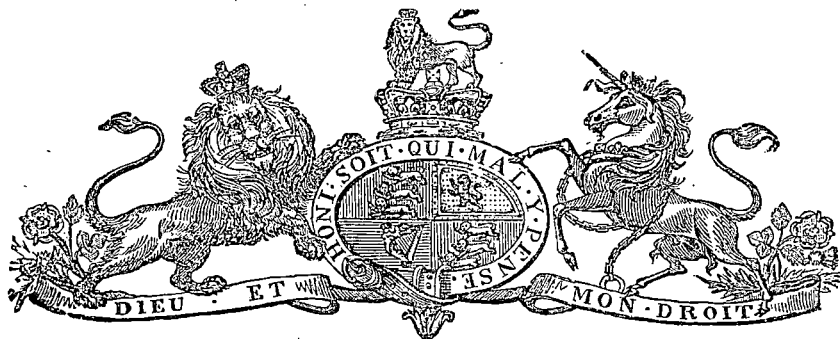

To the Honorable Members of the House of Assembly of the Island of Tasmania, in Parliament assembled.

The Memorial of the undersigned Landholders and Householders in the District of Fingal, Island of Tasmania.

SHOWETH :

THAT your Memorialists have read with surprise that a letter has been laid before your Honorable House by the Honorable the Attorney-General, signed by nine Magistrates of the District of Fingal, praying that the Police Magistrate may be retained ; " as the circumstances of the District are such, that the withdrawal of that Officer would be attended with great injury, both to persons and property, throughout its length and breadth," &c.

Your Memorialists are of opinion that such is not the fact ; but believe that the reduction contemplated by the Government, under the present Estimates before your Honorable House, will meet the requirements of the District in maintaining law and order.
