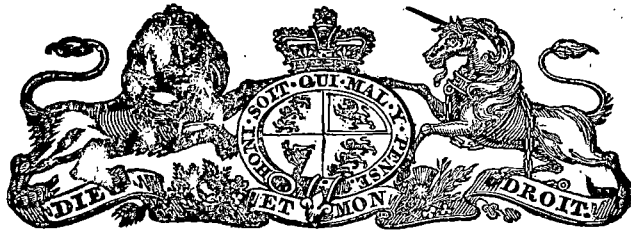

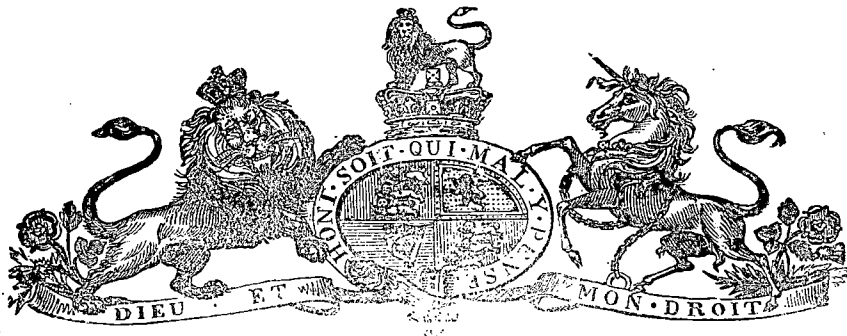

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

ADMINISTRATOR OF CHARITABLE GRANTS:

REPORT FOR 1880.

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Moore, and ordered by the Council to be printed,
July 19, 1881.

SIR,

IN accordance with your instructions, I have the honor to forward herewith a Return of Expenditure for Out-door Relief in the Country Districts during the last six months of the years 1879 and 1880 respectively, showing a decrease in favour of the latter of £724 3s. 6d. That sum added to the amount £448 16s. 9d., shown in the Return furnished on the 30th July last as the decrease in the expenditure during the first six months of 1880, as compared with a corresponding period of 1879, gives a total of £1173 0s. 3d. for the whole year 1880.

I have also the honor to enclose a Return showing the names, ages, and religion of the children maintained under the Boarding-out System in the Country Districts during the year 1880, the date when first boarded-out, the names of the foster parents, the districts in which they resided, and the amount of allowance paid weekly in each case.

The total number included in the Return is 49. Boys, 24; girls, 25; and the expenditure on their account amounted to £433 19s. 0d.

Thirty-three of the children were maintained for the full term of twelve months, and the remaining sixteen for shorter periods, varying from sixteen days to eleven months and eleven days.

The actual annual cost per head was £11 3s. 1½d.

On the 1st January, 1880, the number of children boarded-out, as above, was 43. During the year six new names were added to the list, and ten children ceased to be a charge to the Government, under the following circumstances:—Four were taken by their father, one by her mother, two were adopted by their foster parents, one was provided for by his grandmother, one, whose mother was an inmate of the Hospital at New Norfolk at the time of his birth, died, aged nine months, and one was sent to service, under agreement, for three years, leaving 39 on the 1st January, 1881.

From information received from the authorities at Sorell, in which Municipality the child last referred to now resides, I have every reason to believe he is doing well and giving satisfaction to his master.

I am not in a position to state, from personal observation, the manner in which the foster parents discharged their duty to the children entrusted to their care; but the satisfactory reports, furnished from time to time by the Police Magistrates and Wardens who had the children under immediate supervision, justify the belief that they had good comfortable homes and were well and kindly treated.
