

SIR,

On the 25th of February, 1870, Earl Granville addressed to the Governors of the Australian Colonies and of New Zealand a Circular Despatch respecting the working and progress of the system of Conveyancing by Registration of Title as established in those Colonies.

I now have the honor to transmit to you a copy of an Address which has recently been presented to Her Majesty on the same subject, and I request that you will enable me to comply with the terms of the Address so far as it relates to the Colony under your Government.

I enclose a copy of the return of the 8th May, 1872, for convenience of reference.

## HOUSE OF COMMONS.

Registration of Title (British Colonies).

Resolved—That an humble Address be presented to Her Majesty, that she will be graciously pleased to give directions that there be laid before this House a return, supplementary to those laid upon the Table of this House, and ordered to be printed, on the 8th day of May, 1872, reporting on the working and progress of the system of Conveyancing by Registration of Title in operation in the Colonies of South Australia, Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria, Tasmania, Western Australia, New Zealand, British Columbia, and Fiji; such returns to be made up to the 31st day of December, 1879.

Ordered—That the said Address be presented to Her Majesty by such Members of this House as are of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council.

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your memo. of the 5th instant, together with copy of the Despatch of the Earl of Kimberley, dated 1st September last, requesting me to furnish you for the Secretary of State with a Report upon the working of "The Real Property Act," supplementary to that furnished by the Recorder of Titles on the 5th July, 1870.

With the view of affording full information as to the progress made in carrying out the provisions of "The Real Property Act" since the Report of the 5th July, 1870. I have had the honor to prepare and now append a detailed statement, in a tabular form, of the transactions completed by the Department to 31st December, 1879.

Upon reference to the appended Returns, it will be evident that the area of land both in town and country brought under the provisions of "The Real Property Act" has been annually widely extending; and I am happy to be able to state that no serious difficulty has been found in carrying out the numerous subsequent transactions relating thereto.

On the 31st December, 1879, registrations as follows had been effected:—5241 Certificates of Title and 5082 Land Grants, including 12,600 acres Town Land and 702,041 acres Country Land, valued at £1,442.941. 2274 Mortgages, securing £913,259; 2785 Transfers, conveying 4451 acres Town Land and 274,962 acres Country Land, for the sum of £639,926; 1005 Releases of Mortgage relating to £372,878; 112 Assignments of Mortgages relating to £57,429; 112 Leases of 98 acres Town Land and 49,696 acres Country Land.

The amount standing to the credit of the Assurance Fund on 31st December, 1879, was £3683 7s. This fund is composed of the almost inappreciable sum of  $\frac{1}{4}d$  in the Pound on the declared value of all land brought under the Act, or afterwards transmitted. The amount of this contribution as it accumulates is invested in Government Debentures.

"The Real Property Act" has now been in operation in this Colony for more than 18 years; and I consider that indefeasibility of title has been practically secured, inasmuch as I am not aware of any case in which a registered title has been upset upon reference to the Law Courts of the Colony.

No claim has been made upon the Assurance Fund, nor has any person received compensation therefrom.

A large proportion of the transactions relating to property under the Act is now carried out by members of the legal profession, although in my opinion neither professional knowledge nor experience are essential for safely conducting most of the dealings with land; but parties conversant with the Torrens system frequently fill up and sign the proper forms without professional aid, and occasionally the clerks in the office have afforded assistance in filling up forms for persons unacquainted with the necessary details. In some Colonies, where title by registration has been introduced, numerous Land Brokers have been licensed for the purpose of assisting the public; but in Tasmania the new system has been accepted by the legal profession and worked, I believe, without much additional expense to clients.

On 31st December, 1879, land in this Colony to the extent of 4,193,445 acres had been alienated from the Crown, and of this amount 714,641 acres, or more than one-sixth, are under the Act: it may therefore, I think, be predicted that the majority of transactions in real property will soon be conducted through the Lands' Titles Office, which may now be considered as the statutory conveyancer of the Colony.

No practical difficulty has been experienced in working the new system with respect to mortgages and leases. The forms provided by "The Real Property Act" have been generally found sufficient, or in some cases these forms have been modified as the character of the parties or the circumstances of the case required. Leases have been assigned and surrendered, and mortgages have been transferred and released with such ease and rapidity as to astonish those previously acquainted only with the old and cumbrous system of conveyancing.

The alterations in "The Real Property Act" which from time to time have been considered necessary are comparatively unimportant, and I am not aware of any serious defect (either in principle or in detail) in the existing law urgently requiring legislation.

Upon reviewing the operations of "The Real Property Act," with which I have been officially connected from its commencement in this Colony, (1st July, 1862), I can come to no other conclusion than that title by registration is a simple, expeditious, and economical method of dealing with land, untrammelled by the costly and complex machinery of the old mode of conveyancing;

and, being free from technicalities, with the exercise of vigilant care and caution as to accuracy, the new system of land transfer may commonly be worked by any person possessing ordinary intelligence and business capacity.
