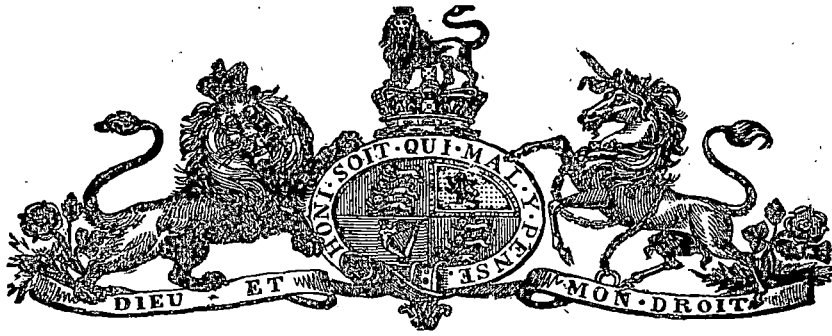

The Petition of the Corporation of the City of Hobart,

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :

1. THAT, without the sanction or approval of this Corporation, a Bill has been passed by the House of Assembly as follows :—Bill No. 16.—“ A Bill to further amend the ‘ Hobart Corporation Act, 1893.’ ” Clause No. 4.—“ Every citizen whose name is on the Assessment Roll as the owner or occupier of any land or building therein mentioned shall “ have a number of votes proportionate to the annual value of such land or building “ according to the scale set forth in Section Four of the said Act, in the same manner “ and to the same extent as if the name of such citizen appeared in the Assessment “ Roll as the occupier of such land or building.”
2. And your Petitioners pray that Clause 4 may be eliminated from this Bill.
