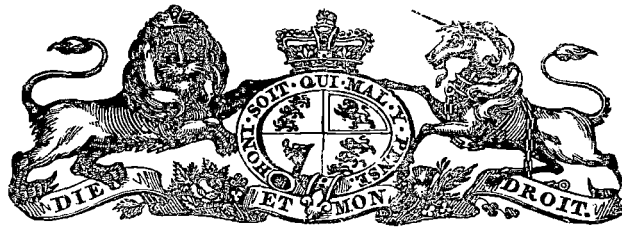

REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1878.

THE Trustees congratulate the Subscribers on the satisfactory state of the funds, which show a balance to credit on 31st December, 1878, of £80 4s. 4d.

On this date after payment of all expenses for 1878, the balance in favour of the Hospital Fund, which has recently been supplemented by the Government aid to December, 1878, will be found to be £73 16s. 11d.

The Treasurer reports this to be a fair working balance to begin the year 1879 with; but as no further aid can be expected from Government till July, and some of the oldest subscribers have not paid their subscriptions for the past year, he deprecates any present reduction of the balance in hand by gratuities, or the present quarter's liabilities cannot be met.

Number of cases treated, 57, of which 4 have died in Hospital, 3 remain under treatment, and 50 have been discharged. 679 out-door patients have received attention and treatment during the year.

The patients have duly received the religious ministrations of the Clergy, and Mr. and Mrs. Raiker are as attentive as ever to their charge.

Dr. Lever has been appointed to the medical charge *vice* Stokell, who resigned. The Doctor is very attentive, and takes great interest in the institution, having already effected a reduction in medical comforts.
