SIR,

I HAVE the honor to return your Balance Sheet and Statements of Account for the year 1873, certified in the usual manner, and to append my Report in accordance with Sections 22 and 23 of "The Audit Act."

Public Debt.—Statements similar to Nos. 7 and 8 of this paper have been printed from year to year for the purpose of showing the Debt of the Colony on 31st December, upon a recommendation of a Royal Commission appointed by His Excellency the Governor in the year 1863; but as these accounts do not include as a debit the outstanding liabilities, or as a credit the expected receipts for the year not collected, as on 31st December, they do not correctly give the state of the Debt at the given date; the amount stated being for General Revenue £996,254 7s. 4d., for Land Fund £485,642 10s. 5d.: total £1,481,896 17s. 9d. The statement of the Public Loans of the Colony, published from year to year, more correctly indicates the Debt of the Government; and on 31st December, 1873, the Loan Account stood as follows:—

As the statements 7 and 8 referred to above are evidently misleading, I beg to suggest that they be abandoned for the future.

Extraordinary Expenditure for which no provision has been made by Parliament.—1. On 30th October, 1873, I addressed a letter to you pointing out that, by an oversight, the sum available from original votes under Act 29 Vict. No. 2, was supposed to be larger by £5244 0s. 8d. than was actually the case, and that the expense of certain works authorised under Act 31 Vict. No. 23, was not fully provided for in consequence of this mistake: the matter had been fully explained in a letter from this office to the Colonial Treasurer, dated 8th May, 1872, but no provision has subsequently been made by Parliament.

2. The sum of £355 10s. was advanced to the South Esk Bridge Trustees during the year 1873, to pay part of interest due upon the Debentures issued by the Trust, which the Trustees were unable to meet from the funds; and unless some arrangement can be made for a repayment of the amount, a vote should be taken to cover the same during the next Session of Parliament: the matter has been referred to in my communication to you of the 2nd October, 1873.

3. A Loan of £1000 has been authorised by the Governor in Council to the Tarleton Road Trust, under Act 35 Vict. No. 7. This Act authorises the Government to lend money for the Construction of Roads upon mortgage of special Rates to be raised under the provisions of the "Cross and Bye Roads Act," but no fund appears to have been provided from which to advance the amounts that may be required: £500 of the amount authorised has been temporarily advanced from the Revenue, and it is desirable that proper provision should be made by Parliament.

† £15,000 was placed in the Banks as a fixed deposit for 8 months on the 19th May last, for the purpose of redeeming a portion of these Treasury Bills due in January, 1875.

I may mention that a further sum of £300 was invested in Debentures by the Recorder of Titles in April last.

In a letter to you, dated 21st October, 1873, I pointed out that the investment of this Fund had not apparently been made in accordance with the provisions of the "Real Property Act," and asking to be supplied with the necessary authority for the arrangement carried out; but I have not yet been favoured with a reply.

Advances for Local Public Works.—On 26th January last I addressed a letter to you asking for information as to arrangements that might have been made for repayment of principal and interest on the amount expended for Local Public Works. I have not yet received a reply to this letter, but notice that the sum of £47 had been received at the Treasury on 8th April last as part payment of interest on the amount expended on the Penguin Breakwater.

Queries and Observations unanswered.—On the 1st June last I forwarded a letter to you with a long list of Queries and Observations from this office unanswered to date; and I regret to find that only one query, No. 330, has been satisfied to the present time.

Marine Board Accounts.—I regret to have to state that the accounts of the Circular Head and Mersey Marine Boards have not yet been passed, in consequence of neglect on the part of the respective Master Wardens to satisfy queries and observations raised by this office.
