# **REPEAL OF REGULATIONS POSTPONEMENT BILL 2008**

*(Brought in by the Premier, the Honourable David John  
Bartlett)*

## **A BILL FOR**

### **An Act to postpone the repeal of certain regulations and by-laws**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by  
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Repeal of  
Regulations Postponement Act 2008*.

#### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on the day on which this  
Act receives the Royal Assent.

#### **3. Postponement of repeals**

- (1) The staged repeals of the regulations and by-laws specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 that, but for this section, were to have been effected on the respective dates specified in column 2 of that Schedule are postponed until 1 January 2010.

(2) Subsection (1) does not prevent any of the regulations and by-laws specified in Schedule 1 from being repealed before 1 January 2010.

(3) In this section –

**“staged repeals”** means repeals effected by section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

**4. Administration of Act**

Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Planning and Workplace Relations; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Justice.

**5. Expiry**

This Act expires on 2 January 2010.
