A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* in order to remove forestry exemptions and to ensure compliance with the provisions of the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995*.

Be it enacted by His Excellency The Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Threatened Species Protection*(Remove Forestry Exemptions) Amendment Act 2003.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* is referred to as the Principal Act.
