- 1 The House met at 30 minutes past Nine o'clock a.m.
- 2 **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.** - The Speaker made a statement acknowledging the traditional people of the land.
- 3 **PRAYERS AND REFLECTION.** - The Speaker read Prayers.
- 4 **QUESTIONS SEEKING INFORMATION.** - In accordance with Standing Order No. 43, Questions without notice were asked.
- 5 **SUSPENSION OF SITTING.** - At twenty-eight minutes past Ten o'clock, the Speaker announced that he would resume the Chair at the ringing of the Division Bells.

At thirty minutes past Eleven o'clock the Speaker resumed the Chair.

- 6 **MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ENTER THE HOUSE FOR TABLING OF COMMISSION OF INQUIRY REPORT AND MINISTERIAL STATEMENT.** - The Speaker said:- "In accordance with the Resolution passed by the House of Assembly on 14 September 2023, I now invite Members of the Legislative Council to enter the House for the tabling of the Commission of Inquiry Report and Ministerial Statement."

Accordingly, the Sergeant-at-Arms escorted Members of the Legislative Council onto the Floor of the House.

- 7 **PAPERS.** - The Clerk of the House laid upon the Table of the House the following Paper:-

‘Who was looking after me? Prioritising the safety of Tasmanian Children,’ the Final Report of the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government’s Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings.

- 8 **MINISTERIAL STATEMENT: TABLING OF THE FINAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO THE TASMANIAN GOVERNMENT’S RESPONSES TO CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE IN INSTITUTIONAL SETTINGS.** - The Premier made a Statement to the House in relation to the Tabling of the Final Report of the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government’s Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings.

- 9 **MINISTERIAL STATEMENT NOTED.** - A Motion was made and the Question proposed - That the Ministerial Statement made by the Premier be noted. (Ms White)

A debate arose thereupon.

And the Question being put.

It was resolved in the Affirmative.
