REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Sheridan (for Mr. Treasurer), December 8, 1926, and ordered by the House of Assembly to be printed.

REPORT.

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report for the favourable consideration of your Honourable House:—

CIRCULAR HEAD MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a Loan of £1500 for the purpose of defraying the cost of taking over from the Trustees all that property known as the Smithton Recreation Ground Reserve, situated at Smithton, with all buildings and structures thereon. The Committee resolved to defer the application until further information could be secured

LEVEN MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £1000 for the purpose of extending the Ulverstone Lighting Scheme. After due consideration the Committee resolved to recommend the granting of the loan at a sinking fund of two per cent.

ZEEHAN MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £2000 for the purpose of defraying the cost of and incidental to the completion and carrying out of a change-over in the Municipal Electric Light and Power Supply from direct current to alternating current. After fully considering the application, it was resolved to defer the granting of the loan until a later date.
