PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

PUBLIC ACCOUNTS:
REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Treasurer, December 6, 1928, and ordered by the House of Assembly to be printed.

REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report:—

MUNICIPALITY OF GLENORCHY.

This was an application for a loan of £12,000 for the purpose of constructing certain private streets within the Town of Moonah, in the said municipality, in accordance with the provisions of the Town Boards Act, 1896, and its amendments.

After due consideration your Committee decided to recommend the granting of the loan.

MUNICIPALITY OF DEVONPORT.

This was an application for a loan of £3000 to the said municipality for the purposes of defraying the cost and expenses of and incidental to the completion, carrying out, or extension of all or any of the works or objects authorised under the Devonport Lighting Act, 1928.

After carefully considering the abovementioned application it was decided to recommend the granting of the loan, subject to provision being made for a sinking fund of 2 per cent.

MUNICIPALITY OF BURNIE.

This was an application for a loan of £25,000 for the purpose of increasing and improving the supply of water for the use of the inhabitants of the Town of Burnie and contiguous districts.

Your Committee decided to recommend the granting of the loan, subject to a favourable report on the proposed work being furnished by the Engineer of Works, and subject also to a provision being made for a sinking fund of 1½ per cent.

MUNICIPALITY OF SCOTTSDALE.

This was an application for a loan of £3,000 for duplicating certain Electric Lighting.

Your Committee decided to recommend the loan, subject to provision being made for a sinking fund of 2 per cent
