REPORT.

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following report:—

FLINDERS MUNICIPAL LOAN.

This was an application from the Flinders Municipality for a loan of £600 for the purpose of making a permanent and efficient aerodrome near Whitemark, at Flinders Island.

After carefully considering the application, your Committee decided to recommend the loan, subject to the Treasurer satisfying himself that proper arrangements are entered into between the Council and the aviation companies concerned in regard to the use of the aerodrome, and that approval is obtained from the Civil Aviation Department as to the suitability of the proposed aerodrome, and that such conditions be embodied in the Bill when it comes before the House for consideration.
