

No receipts in excess of £25 are reckoned in the calculations. The deduction of 8s. 3½d. in the £ is made in every case. The calculation on the basis adopted came to £350 1s. 7d. The excess of 1s. 7d. was provided for by deducting 1d. from the Bagdad, Bothwell, Devon Institute, Ringarooma, St. Mary's, and Ulverstone Libraries, and ½d. from each of the following Libraries, viz.—Beaconsfield, Bellerive Institute, Campbell Town, Deloraine, Don Mechanics' Institute, Evandale, Formby, Franklin, George Town, Glenora (United), Forth, Lefroy, Longford, Latrobe, Mount Bischoff Mechanics' Institute, New Norfolk, Oatlands, Penguin, Port Esperance, Richmond, Scottsdale, Sorell, Stanley, St. Helen's, Westbury, and Wynyard.
